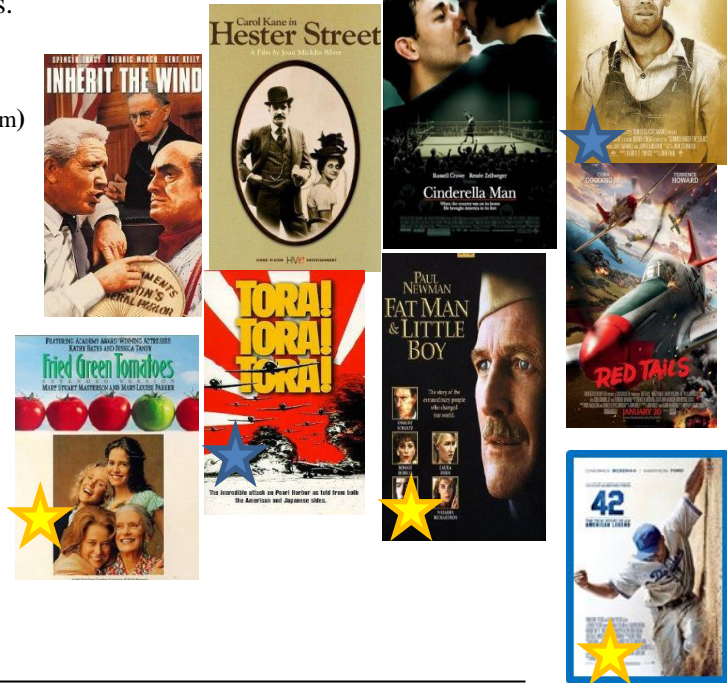


Grab a friend... rent a movie, talk about history, and write a review.
