

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET PRAYER March 29, through Saturday April 6

In preparation for the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday on April 7, we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet at 3:00 pm, from Friday, March 29, through Saturday, April 6. The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy, is a devotion to the Divine Mercy of Jesus. It is based on the Christological apparitions of Jesus reported by St. Faustina Kowalska. The Lord promised to grant every possible grace to souls who recite it. Confession times are: Good Friday, after the Divine Mercy Chaplet, on Holy Saturday after the Divine Mercy Chaplet, on Holy Saturday after the Divine Mercy Chaplet for a limited time, and on Easter Sunday at the regular time. Next weekend confessions will be available on Friday April 5, 6, 7, at the regular times but not after the Divine Mercy Chaplet. To obtain a plenary indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday, one must follow these requirements:

Commence a Novena to the Divine Mercy on Good Friday, the Novena includes special intentions for each day and is concluded with the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet Sacramental confession

- · Eucharistic Communion
- · Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father
- Pray "a devout invocation" to Christ such as "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you"
- · Perform acts of mercy
- Come to Jesus with a humble and contrite heart, repent of all _your sins
- · Celebrate the feast on the first Sunday after Easter.
