ELIGIBILITY AND HIEGHT DIVISIONS

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register-able breeds that have obtained PAL/ILP numbers from the American Kennel Club, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. **Mixed breed dogs** listed in the AKC Canine Partners program are eligible to enter this all-breed AKC agility trial. Mixed breed dogs entered in these events must list the breed name as "Canine Partner" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and must include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. Box.

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all **regular classes:**

8" for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 4"
12" for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 8"
16" for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 12"
20" for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers Preferred class: 16"
24" for dogs over 22 inches at the withers Preferred class: 20"
26" dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion Preferred class: N/A

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all international classes (if offered):

for dogs 13-3/4 inches and under at the withers (mini dogs)

Jump Height Information

All dogs without height cards will have to be measured by the judge of record, except 24"/26" dogs. If a VMO or an AKC Representative is available, all dogs without height cards, including 24"/26" dogs, will need to be measured. When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured.
