

## IPCR Outreach Efforts (2005--2012)

The Interfaith Peacebuilding and Community Revitalization (IPCR) Initiative

From 2005--2012, this writer carried out four major outreach initiatives--to share educational resources, and in an effort to build The Interfaith Peacebuilding and Community Revitalization (IPCR) Initiative. Below are descriptions of those outreach efforts, with links to key documents used in each outreach effort.

### IPCR Outreach 2005

The key document for the first IPCR Initiative outreach campaign was [“The IPCR Journal/Newsletter Spring 2005” issue](#) (14 pages). That Spring 2005 issue is also noteworthy because it contains detailed descriptions of seven of The Eight IPCR Concepts—and much of that content has remained as it was written then... as it evolved into [“Brief Descriptions of The Eight IPCR Concepts”](#) (2009); then [“Ten Steps for Long Term Culture Change”](#) (2014); and then [“13 Steps for Long Term Culture Change”](#) (2017) (a second CPCS Initiative Summary Paper).

### IPCR Outreach 2008

In June, 2008, this writer completed a 161 page proposal titled [“1000Communities<sup>2</sup>”](#)—which advocated for Community Visioning Initiatives, "Community Teaching and Learning Centers" with ongoing workshops, and "sister community" relationships as a way of generating an exponential increase in our collective capacity to overcome the challenges of our times. IPCR Outreach 2008 was an effort to introduce the “1000Communities<sup>2</sup>” proposal by sending out an “Educational Materials Outreach Package” to many individuals and organizations, which included a summary of the “1000Communities<sup>2</sup>” Proposal titled [“1000Communities<sup>2</sup> Proposal: Creating a Multiplier Effect of a Positive Nature ” \(in an 11" x 17" format-- display size\)](#)].

### IPCR Outreach 2011

From February 2011 through April 2011. Believing there is an urgent need to build bridges between diverse communities of people, this writer (founder and outreach coordinator, Stefan Pasti) sent out

summary information about The IPCR Initiative ([“A Four Page Summary of The IPCR Initiative”](#)) to many people, in many related fields of activity.

### IPCR Outreach 2012

From July 2011 to January 2012, this writer gave much attention to an “IPCR Critical Challenges Assessment 2011-2012” project. Due to accumulated evidence and unfolding events, one of the sections which was part of that assessment became a preview of what the final report for the whole “Assessment” project might look like. The title: “Calling ‘the better angels of our nature’: A Multi-Angle View of the Debt Crises” (January, 2012) (398 pages)(a document which I no longer have a file for). The documents for “IPCR Outreach 2012” mailings reference the “Multi-Angle” document, and were created to emphasize a) the nature and depth of the challenges ahead b) the urgency for honest, respectful, and responsible public discourse on the nature and depth of the challenges ahead c) the potential of Community Visioning Initiatives and “Community Teaching and Learning Centers” to provide significant support for the “problem solving on a scale most of us have never known before” that we needed to do.
