

# New York Aster

This Native perennial has a long bloom period. It attracts lots of butterflies and pollinators. Asters are a larval host plant for over 100 species of butterflies and moths. There is great variation in flower color from plant to plant. Also known as Michaelmas Daisy it will perform best in a moist to wet meadow and is known to be deer resistant.

- Hardiness Zone: 4-8
- Size: 3-5'
- Flower: 1-2" wide clusters of pink, purple or white from late Summer through Fall
- Culture: Prefers full to part sun and moist well-drained soils
- Uses: Border, naturalizing, erosion, rain garden, cut flower, meadow, butterflies, pollinators, birds, deer, drought and Black Walnut tolerant
