<p><b>January - Weather</b> An image that depicts weather but NOT a beautiful sunshiny day. Storm clouds, rain, sleet, snow, ice, wind, fog, rainbows are all acceptable.</p>	<p><b>January – Street Photography</b> Photography that features the human condition within public places not necessarily on a “street”. Assignment must include a person or persons. In color or black and white.</p>
<p><b>March - Still Life</b> Make an artful arrangement of articles of your choosing, provide just the right light and photograph it. Last year's “Image of the Year” by Barbara Hunley is an excellent example as are beautiful paintings of the old masters. Let your creative juices flow and create a “master piece”.</p>	<p><b>March – Texas Landscape in B&amp;W</b> May be panorama, intimate or any scale in between. The location should be the title (but make it brief!)</p>
<p><b>May - Let's Go Shoot Animals!</b> Animal(s) Four legged, warm blooded animals. Not birds, reptiles or bugs! Your pet or a wild beast whatever suits your fancy. A portrait of a single animal or an animal family. Color, black &amp; white, or monochrome. Your choice.</p>	<p><b>May – Action Shots of People</b> We are talking about people who are moving be it sports, exercise, work, play, dance, etc. Could be riding a bicycle but not a car or motorcycle. Could be rowing a boat but not riding in a motor boat. MUST DEMONSTRATE ACTION! Color or monochrome.</p>
<p><b>July - Trees</b> Big trees, little trees, single tree, grove or row of trees. Just make the principle subject trees. They can be blooming, in fall color or have no leaves at all. Standing dead trees are acceptable. Color or monochrome.</p>	<p><b>July – Urban Night Photography</b> Subjects might be reflections, neon signs, streaking lights, skylines, monuments, fireworks, individual buildings, street lights, carnivals, museums, overlooks and views, bridges, fountains. <b>Color only.</b></p>
<p><b>September - Highways and Byways</b> A path, trail, sidewalk, road, street or highway serving as the leading lines into your image. Make it something that the viewer might want to travel on. Or it could be something daunting that might challenge them. The important thing is that draws them in to something beautiful, interesting or mystical. Color only</p>	<p><b>September - To be assigned</b></p>
<p><b>November – Wheels</b> A mode of transportation that is on wheels with the wheels being the main point of interest. Trains, bicycles, tricycles, motorbike/cycle, cars (old or new) trucks are all fair game as well as anything else you find that is on wheels and provides transportation.
