Just As Your Father Is Merciful

From the following verses record your observations which define, illustrate and demonstrate how mercy is applied. You will discover that many Biblical terms and concepts are related to mercy and used interchangeably with it, such as; goodness, lovingkindness, forgiveness, patience (longsuffering), love, God's faithfulness, compassion, grace, and others. Matthew 5:7 informs us that we will be blessed (spiritually prosperous; happy and will receive mercy) when we show mercy. Matthew 7:12 gives us a powerful relational principle or dynamic that can transform our lives and our attitudes, particularly toward others. It is that we are to treat others the way in which we want to be treated! The title of this study is based on Luke 6:36. Our basis of motivation to apply this principle comes from God's own example in how He has been merciful to us. This same principle is seen in Eph. 4:32 and Jn. 13:15,34. We can only show mercy when we ourselves know and learn experientially how God has been this way to us. When this first hand experience is ours, it will flow out of us in specific ways to others in need.
