Competition Notable Items

- No radios or any two-way communication devices (including phones) of any kind.
- Starts and restarts will all be double file. The leader has the option to swap lanes. There will be a designated start and restart line/area.
- Following red flags past halfway in the feature, lead lap cars will advance to the front of the lineup unless they have pitted during said red flag or caused that red.
- We race under the yellow flag. The yellow flag will be waved to alert drivers of a minor hazard such as a spun/stalled car, small debris, light fluid, etc. The race will either then return to green flag conditions when cleared or you will see a red flag to clear it up.
- Other items can be addressed in the drivers meeting

Car Guidelines

- Eligibility – Cars built to the Outlaw Late Model Figure 8 car construction rules of tracks that have active Figure 8 racing may compete pending approval.
- Safety – Insurance requires that any part of the Figure 8 car that relates to driver protection must not be changed from the rules and conditions under which it has raced on the Figure 8. The driver must wear a full uniform and Snell 2010 SA rated helmet or newer while on track.
- Weight – 2450 pounds minimum with driver before entering the racing surface.
- Tires – American Racer 955 (new or used). New tires sold at the track. NO TIRE ALTERING CHEMICALS! Driver and car will be disqualified WITHOUT PAY and out for the week.
- Wheels – Maximum 10" wide wheel is permitted during the series.
- Roof – A roof is optional. The roof can be any style with a maximum height of 62". Safety is #1. There must be complete cockpit openings on both sides for a driver to escape and for safety personal access to remove you in an accident. Opening must be minimum of 12" in height and the length of the cockpit. THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY!
- Rear Spoiler – 43" max. from the ground. Sideboard Wings – 62" max. from the ground.
- Bumpers and Rub Bars – Front bumper width to not exceed 64" total. There can be NO exposed ends or any sharp points. Ends must be capped and rounded.
