

## **2 PRIMARY VERSES:**

MATTHEW 22:37-40 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments."

<u>1 JOHN 4:10-12</u> This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins. <sup>11</sup> Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. <sup>12</sup> No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

#### **ADDITIONAL REFERENCES:**

**JEREMIAH 31:3** The LORD appeared to us in the past, saying: "I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.

MATTHEW 5:43-45 "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' 44 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, 45 that you may be children of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous.

**JOHN 15:12-13** My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. <sup>13</sup> Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends.

<u>1 CORINTHIANS 13:4-7; 13</u> Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup> It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup> It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. ... And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

<u>EPHESIANS 5:1-2</u> Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children <sup>2</sup> and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

**QUESTION OF THE DAY: WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO SACRIFICIALLY & UNCONDITIONALLY LOVE OTHERS?** 

**DILEMMA**: HOW TO DISTINGUISH BETWEEN:

"WE LOVE CHOCOLATE" AND "WE LOVE OUR CHILDREN"

"WE LOVE THAT SONG" AND "WE LOVE GOD"

The New Testament writers, particularly Paul and John, took an existing but little used word from the Greek language and imputed it with new meaning that might be used to reflect the powerful concept of "GOD CENTERED LOVE."

Isn't it cool that the 1<sup>st</sup> century Christians desire to find a better way to express a "Christian" type of love uniquely centered upon God's love resulted in a very special word?

## **UNIQUE DISTINCTION OF "AGAPE" LOVE:**

#### **UNCONDITIONAL LOVE**

- + AGAPE LOVE IS NOT DEPENDENT ON LOVE GIVING BACK.
- + AGAPE LOVE PUTS NO CONDITIONS, EXPECTATIONS, OR STIPULATIONS UPON A PERSON BEFORE THEY ARE LOVED

#### **SACRIFICIAL LOVE**

+ AGAPE LOVE GIVES ITSELF UP AND TAKES RISKS FOR THE WELFARE AND CARE OF --- OTHERS --- WANTING GOD'S BEST FOR THEM AND BEING WILLING TO EXPEND ENERGY TO SEE GOD'S BEST MADE REAL IN THEIR LIFE

#### **FORGIVING LOVE**

- + AGAPE LOVE EXPRESSES THAT "YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE PERFECT FOR ME TO LOVE YOU"
- + IN FACT, I AM ALREADY COMMITTED TO FORGIVING YOU BECAUSE I KNOW THAT YOU ARE NOT PERFECT.

### APPLYING GOD'S LOVE TO OUR WORLD AND OUR LIVES:

I AM THEIR ADVOCATE
I SACRIFICE MY RIGHTS TO SEE THEM SUCCEED
I HELP THEM SEE GOD'S GOOD FOR THEM

- \* GOD'S GRACE ENABLES ME TO FORGIVE PEOPLE WHO HAVE HURT ME
- \* I REJOICE WHEN GOOD THINGS HAPPEN TO OTHER PEOPLE
- \* I DEMONSTRATE LOVE EQUALLY TOWARD PEOPLE OF ALL RACES, CREEDS, AND LIFESTYLES
- \* I FREQUENTLY GIVE UP WHAT I WANT FOR THE SAKE OF OTHERS

**BOTTOM-LINE**: AS I GROW IN CHRISTIAN MATURITY AND CHRIST-LIKENESS I BECOME A BETER AND BETTER EXPRESSION OF GOD'S AGAPE LOVE FOR ME AND FOR ALL OF HIS CHURCH.

WHAT AND HOW SHOULD I PRAY TO GOD TO HELP ME BE A BETTER EXPRESSION OF AGAPE LOVE RIGHT HERE AND RIGHT NOW? i.e. IN THE CONTEXT OF MY FAMILY, CHURCH, LIFE AND WORLD THAT I LIVE RIGHT HERE AND RIGHT NOW --- FEBRUARY 2021?

AS WE CLOSE ... LET'S NAME IT IN OUR HEARTS ... CONFESSING OUR STRUGGLE AND COMMITTING OUR DESIRE & WILL TO LIFT 'THIS PERSON' AND 'OUR RELATIONSHIP' TO GOD AS AN OFFERING AND A PRAYER THAT WE MAY BE A SOURCE OF GOD'S LIGHT IN A DARK WORLD.
