Kansas pulled off a huge upset last week beating Texas 57-56 in OT as 31-point underdogs. The Jayhawks were nearly 23/1 on the money-line. The win snapped a 56-game road losing streak in Big 12 play for Kansas. It was Texas' 5th straight loss, a first for them since 1956!

Misleading Finals

Kansas St beat West Virginia 34-17. However, West Virginia had a 345-299 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. Kansas St also got a blocked punt TD.

Georgia St upset Coastal Carolina 42-40. However, Coastal had a 442-373 yard edge but were -2 in TO's. Georgia St got 2 TD drives on a total of 9 yards of offense!

Kansas shocked Texas 57-56 in OT. However, it must be noted that Texas did have a 574-420 yard edge but were -4 in TO's.

UL-Lafayette beat Troy 35-21. However, Troy had a 391-370 yard edge but were -3 in TO's.

Bad Beats

Last week we had South Alabama +22.5 over Appalachian St as a best bet on these pages. It was by far our worst beat of the season as you could make a case that South Alabama could've won the game as a 3-TD plus dog. The Jags were stopped

on downs at the App St 15-yard line, stopped on downs at the App St 32-yard line, stopped on downs at the App St 4-yard line, missed a 40-yard FG and threw a 100-yard "Pick 6" with under 3 minutes left when trailing 24-7 and inside the App St's 10-yard line! App St also scored two TD's on fourth down!

The Washington St/Oregon total was 58. UNDER backers had to be feeling good as it was 24-14 with under 10 minutes left. Washington St got a FG with 8:31 left, Oregon a TD with 5:52 left, the Ducks got another TD with 2:07 left and then Washington St put the game OVER with a TD with just :09 left.

Boise St was a 13.5-point home favorite vs Wyoming. The Cowboys were covering the entire game but Boise St got a FG with :59 left to take a 23-7. Wyoming then got a miracle 74-yard TD with just :04 left to get the back-door.

Arizona St (-6) trailed Washington 24-14 with 6 minutes left in the fourth quarter. The Sun Devils got a TD with 5:46 left and another TD with 1:11 left to take a 28-24 lead. Then ASU got a 37-yard interception return TD with :32 left giving Washington backers a bad beat...but wait...the Huskies drove 63 yards in 3 plays and got a TD with :03 left to get the deserved cover.

Injuries/Personnel News

Auburn QB Bo Nix is out for the season with an ankle injury.
Auburn Kicker Anders Carlson (knee) is out for the season.
Clemson WR Justyn Ross (foot) is out for this week's game.
Coastal Carolina QB Grayson McCall (upper body) is listed as the starter on the depth chart this week.
Iowa QB Spencer Petras is questionable.
North Carolina QB Sam Howell (upper body) is day-to-day...aren't we all?
South Alabama QB Jake Bentley (knee) is questionable vs Tennessee.
Stanford QB Tanner McKee is expected to play vs Cal this week.
UCF QB Dillon Gabriel (shoulder) was back at practice this week. He remains questionable for this week's game.
USC QB Kedon Slovis is out with a leg injury. Jaxson Dart will get the start.
Virginia WR Billy Kemp (leg) is questionable with a leg injury.
Texas RB Bijan Robinson (elbow) is out for the season.

Justin Fuente, who had a 43-31 record in six seasons at Virginia Tech, is out as the Hokies' football coach, athletic director Whit Babcock announced Tuesday. DL coach J.C. Price will serve as interim head coach for the remainder of the season.

Illinois football coach Bret Bielema tested positive for COVID-19 and will not coach in Saturday's game at Iowa.

Washington on Sunday fired second-year football coach Jimmy Lake. Defensive coordinator Bob Gregory will serve as interim coach for the 4-6 Huskies.

FIU coach Butch Davis will not return in 2022. Davis, who has led FIU since 2017, told The Action Network that he's out after the season and criticized the school's administration for "sabotaging the program." FIU last month had a job posting for its head-coaching position online with the American Football Coaches Association.

UConn has hired former UCLA and NFL coach Jim Mora to be its next football coach, athletic director David Benedict announced Thursday. Mora and UConn have agreed to a five-year contract in which he will make \$1.5 million in the first season and could earn another \$200,000 in annual performance incentives. He will begin his head-coaching duties Nov. 28 after serving as an assistant coach for the rest of the 2021 season, which will allow him to recruit.

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Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Wednesday, November 17th

Central Michigan 30 BALL ST 29. Every game is important in the MAC West division. CMU has been in better form down the stretch with wins and covers in their last two while Ball St has failed to cover in 3 straight. The money has come on CMU early in the week. The Chips are No. 84 in ypp margin while Ball St is No. 100. Some wind in the forecast.

Northern Illinois 31 BUFFALO 29. NIU has played the tougher schedule and is slightly better in ypp margin. The Huskies have overachieved this season at 6-3-1 ATS while Buffalo has underachieved at 3-6-1 ATS. Some wind in the forecast has us passing.

Thursday, November 18th

Louisville 38 DUKE 20. We're guessing the David Cutcliffe era is coming to an end. He did a great job in Durham but the program has slipped in recent years. This year, the Blue Devils have been blown out in 4 straight games and could be starting a backup QB here. Meanwhile, Louisville is off a blowout win over Syracuse and needs one more win for bowl eligibility. Massive ypp margin edge for Louisville (No. 44 vs No. 117). They can name the score here but we're passing.

Friday, November 19th

LOUISIANA TECH 31 Southern Miss 17. Last week Southern Miss nearly upset UTSA as a 32.5-point underdog. "We made a decision as a football program to milk the clock and try to reduce the game," Southern Miss coach Will Hall said. Southern Miss started Frank Gore Jr. at quarterback, which caught UTSA off guard defensively. Louisiana Tech won't be caught off guard but if Southern Miss is wanting to shorten the game, you could only look towards the dog and the UNDER here (note we bet UNDER on the openers and would like to have that bet back).

HOUSTON 34 Memphis 25. Believe it or not, Houston is No. 29 in ypp margin while Memphis is No. 30. The Cougars have won 9 straight and just made their first appearance in the CFB Playoff poll on Tuesday night. Memphis is off a tough loss to ECU in OT. We were originally wanting to lean with Houston here but those ypp stats with Memphis playing the tougher schedule raised some eyebrows for us.

WASHINGTON ST 32 Arizona 19. The Wildcats have been super competitive as of late with 4 straight covers. None of their last 3 losses have come by double-digits. Washington St saw their 6-game ATS win streak come up a 0.5-point short at Oregon last week. Wazzu is only No. 82 in ypp margin. We lean with Arizona here.

Nevada 28 AIR FORCE 25. Really solid match-up here with both teams on the outside looking in with regards to the Mountain West championship game. Still this is for bowl positioning. Early money has come in on Nevada in this one and our power ratings agree with it. Nevada is No. 46 in ypp margin, AF is No. 54. Slight lean Nevada.

San Diego St 27 UNLV 16. We were super impressed with UNLV last week as they crushed us on these pages with their upset of Hawaii. The Rainbow Warriors scored a TD on their first offensive play but were dominated from that point forward as UNLV RB Charles Williams rushed for a career-high 266 yards and scored three touchdowns. Meanwhile, San Diego St held on vs Nevada thanks to kicker/punter Matt Araiza who kicked a 35-yard field goal with 1:21 to play. Araiza, who had two other FG's also had five punts for 278 yards (55.6 yards per punt) and leads the FBS this season with 50 punts of 50-plus yards and 15 punts of 60 yards or more! He's having by far the best punting season of anyone in CFB history! We did bet OVER 40.5 on this one but still don't expect a shoot-out.

Saturday, November 20th

PITTSBURGH 38 Virginia 23. This game basically comes down to the health status of UVA QB Brennan Armstrong. If he doesn't play, UVA doesn't have a chance in this one and that's why we bet Pitt -11 on the openers. Armstrong leads the nation in total offense with an average of 425.3 yards. Jay Woolfolk, the first true freshman to start at quarterback for Virginia since Bryan Shumock in 1977, was largely ineffective last week vs ND. He completed 18 of 33 passes for 196 yards, two interceptions and was sacked seven times. "I thought Jay did a nice job," Mendenhall said, adding that "the protection has to hold better. ... Jay's processing takes longer whereas Brennan would have had the ball out much faster." Meanwhile, a win here would clinch the division for Pitt.

2★ SMU (plus the points) CINCINNATI 36 Smu 27. Cincinnati is playing with CFB Playoff pressure. And we emphasize the word PRESSURE because the Bearcats aren't handling it well failing to cover as a big favorite in 4 consecutive games. If they play like they have the last month, they will lose outright to a SMU team that is No. 12 in the country in ppg margin and have the No. 6 offense in the country averaging 498.7 ypp and 41.6 ppg. We bet SMU +13 on the openers.

ARMY 45 Massachusetts 10. UMass is the worst FBS team in the country. They've lose back-to-back games vs FCS teams. They are dead last in ypp margin (-2.76), scoring margin (-28.8) and ypp game (-186.4). They're taking on an Army team that is fresh off a beat down of FCS Bucknell. Eighteen different Army players had a rushing attempt last Saturday. Nine gained at least 23 yards, and 15 had at least 10 yards. According to Sportradar, it's the only game this century that has had so many different players on the same team have at least one carry. Just as many could get a carry this week.

CENTRAL FLORIDA 44 Connecticut 14. Another game and another big mismatch here. UConn got a kick return TD on the first play last week at Clemson and then proceeded to get shutout from that point forward 44-0. The Huskies will be facing an angry UCF team off a blowout loss to SMU last week.

MIAMI, FL 32 Virginia Tech 23. Justin Fuente, who had a 43-31 record in six seasons at Virginia Tech, is out as the Hokies' football coach, athletic director Whit Babcock announced Tuesday. DL coach J.C. Price will serve as interim head coach for the remainder of the season. Miami could also be looking for a new coach if they don't win their last two games of the season. The Hurricanes allowed a 4th&14 conversion in the final minute and lost at rival Florida St last week. Can they rebound here? We did bet Miami -7 on the openers.

NC STATE 31 Syracuse 21. What a horrific effort by Syracuse coming off a bye last week. The Orange had covered 7 straight games and need one more win for bowl eligibility. The blowout loss to Louisville has us staying away. Meanwhile, what is NC State's mind-set as their ACC chances took a major hit in a loss to Wake last week. We're not involved here.

Kent St 44 AKRON 30. Kent St has covered 5 straight in this Wagon Wheel rivalry. Kent St's offense should have a ton of success here vs an Akron defense that allows 7.1 yards per play (No. 127). If you're wondering why the total is so high, Kent St's conference games are averaging 79 total ppg. That's after their non-conference games averaged only 53 total ppg. Also Akron's offense is coming off their best performance of the season.

OHIO ST 42 Michigan St 23. A match-up of Top 7 teams in the CFB Playoff. If you're wondering why Ohio St is nearly a 3-TD favorite here look no further than the mismatch between their offense which is No. 1 in the country averaging 550 ypp, 46.3 ppg and 8.0 yards per play taking on a Michigan St defense that allows 443 ypp (No. 110). We do worry about Ohio St's defense allowing a back-door TD vs a MSU offense that ranks No. 10 in ypp (6.8). Our strongest take is that Ohio St QB CJ Stroud will be the Heisman favorite after this one.

COASTAL CAROLINA 41 Texas St 19. The big story here is that on Tuesday Coastal Carolina QB Grayson McCall appeared a top the depth chart for the Chanticleers. McCall missed the last two games due to injury and the Coastal lost outright to Georgia St last week as a double-digit favorite. They'll get back to their winning ways here but we're not laying this big of a number.

Michigan 35 MARYLAND 20. Sandwich spot for Michigan coming off the big win at Penn St last week with the huge game vs Ohio St on deck. Still, the Wolverines are one of the best in the country at 8-2 ATS this year while Maryland has failed to cover in 6 straight games. Maryland head coach Mike Locksley is a great recruiter, he's also a good offensive coordinator. But he's a terrible head coach!

Florida 38 MISSOURI 28. Florida losing 42-35 at halftime to Samford last week was arguably the most shocking score of the season. That's saying something considering how many big upsets there has been this season. The Gators lacked energy, looked lost at times and trailed by as many as 14 points in a game they were favored to win by more than five touchdowns. Dan Mullen's seat is hot! Meanwhile, Missouri got a big win over South Carolina last week. Still, the Tigers are only 2-8 ATS on the season. Our power ratings actually lean Florida here.

WEST VIRGINIA 31 Texas 27. Texas is making history in all the wrong ways both on and off the field in recent weeks. Last week, Kansas stunned Texas 57-56 that snapped a 56-game losing streak in Big 12 road contests that stretched back to 2008. Texas had rallied from 21 down in the second half to force overtime but the Horns have now lost five in a row for the first time since 1956. "Until we figure that out, that it takes discipline, commitment, toughness and accountability all of the time, we're going to be swimming upstream," Sarkisian said. "That's the message to the guys. At some point they've got to recognize that." We don't think they recognize it this week coach especially with their best player RB Bijan Robinson out.

TENNESSEE 42 South Alabama 17. Last week we lost backing both of these teams as best bets. South Alabama was by far our worst beat of the season as you could make a case that they could've won the game as a 3-TD plus dog. The Jags were stopped on downs at the App St 15-yard line, stopped on downs at the App St 32-yard line, stopped on downs at the App St 4-yard line, missed a 40-yard FG and threw a 100-yard "Pick 6" with under 3 minutes left when trailing 24-7 and inside the App St's 10-yard line! App St also scored two TD's on fourth down! We think that misleading final creates some value on them again here. Lean South Alabama and UNDER.

2★ OVER 54.5 BOSTON COLLEGE 30 Florida St 28. We like the OVER here. A lot of BC's offensive stats this season should be thrown out the window as they played without starting QB Phil Jurkovec. The Eagles came through for us last week in a big way in their win over Georgia Tech. Jurkovec accounted for five touchdowns. "Holy cow, what he did today ... I'm glad he's back," said Boston College coach Jeff Hafley of his quarterback. Meanwhile, Florida St is off a big rivalry win over Miami and still have bowl hopes at 4-6.

LIBERTY 28 UL-Lafayette 24. A really good Group of 5 game here. ULL has won 9 straight after losing to Texas in the opener. Meanwhile, Liberty comes in off a bye. Statistically, the Flames are the superior team ranking No. 7 in ypp margin, No. 10 in scoring margin and No. 9 in ypg margin. Meanwhile, ULL ranks No. 43 in ypp, No. 24 on scoring and No. 38 in ypg despite playing a similar schedule in terms of strength. With that said, the opening line was a bit steep and we took ULL +6.5.

† **Purdue 28 Northwestern 19.** @Wrigley Field in Chicago. Purdue has been an overachiever this year and has their sights set on a nice bowl as they'll be double-digit favorites in their last two games (Indiana on deck). Meanwhile, the Wildcats have disappointed at 3-7 SU and ATS. We bet UNDER 51.5 on the Sunday openers. You think offense with Purdue but their games are 7-3 to the UNDER. We bet UNER 51.5 on Sunday.

3★ Minnesota 28 INDIANA 18. We like Minnesota here. The Hoosiers remain banged up at QB and are just 1-8 ATS this season vs FBS teams. The Gophers took a lot of money in the market last week and had a nice performance at Iowa despite the loss. Minnesota had a 409-277 yard edge. Their 189 rushing yards was the most this season against the Hawkeyes, who came into the game ranked eighth nationally in rushing defense at 98.6 yards per game. They'll control the line of scrimmage here.

PENN ST 31 Rutgers 15. We lean with Rutgers here. Rutgers needs just one more win for bowl eligibility. There are a lot more positive vibes around their program considering where they were two years ago. Compare that to a vastly underachieving Penn St program that is just 10-9 straight up the last few years and head coach James Franklin seems like he has one foot out the door.

CLEMSON 29 Wake Forest 25. Obviously, two teams at the opposite ends of expectations this season. Wake is having one of their best in school history and can clinch an ACC Championship game berth with a win here. Meanwhile, Clemson is 2-8 ATS and we've downgraded the Tigers more than any team in the country this season. Still, Wake's high-powered offense is facing by far the best defense they've seen all year and statistically the teams are close with Wake No. 49 in ypp margin and Clemson No. 51.

WISCONSIN 28 Nebraska 17. We've said it for weeks now...Wisconsin is now playing like the team we expected all along. That's 6 straight wins for them now and statistically they're No. 5 in ypp margin (+178.6) and No. 6 in ypp margin (+1.85). They have a +16 sack differential. Despite a 3-7 record, Nebraska has also been statistically impressive at No. 19 in ypp margin. The problem is they're fired basically their entire offensive staff during the bye week and then lost one of their best defensive players in JoJo Doman for the rest of the season. The Huskers have played everyone close so far but we like the Badgers by double-digits.

WESTERN KENTUCKY 36 Florida Atlantic 26. WKU is closing in on a division championship. The Hilltoppers have won 5 straight going 4-1 ATS in that span and boast one of the best offenses in the country. FAU is trending down at 2-3 SU and 1-4 ATS in their last 5 games and last week was upset at ODU. We know you usually think OVER when betting WKU games but FAU does have one of the better defenses WKU has faced in several games. We bet UNDER 67.5 on Sunday.

IOWA 27 Illinois 14. Illinois comes in off a bye but Illinois coach Bret Bielema tested positive for COVID-19 and will not coach in this game. The Illini have pulled two outright upsets as a double-digit underdog in their last 3 games and Iowa is built similar to Penn St and Minnesota who Illinois beat. Still, the Hawkeyes defense that ranks No. 4 in ypp allowed should have great success vs an Illinois offense that ranks No. 118 in ypp on offense.

BOISE ST 35 New Mexico 10. New Mexico is a nation-worst 1-9 ATS this season. The Lobos have failed to cover by an average of 6.4 ppg. Meanwhile, Boise St is playing their best ball of the season with 3 straight wins. They didn't cover last week vs Wyoming in dramatic fashion (see page 1). We bet UNDER 50 on the Sunday openers as it's tough seeing New Mexico's one-dimensional offense having success.

UTAH 31 Oregon 28. If you're surprised that 7-3 and No. 23 (in playoff poll) Utah is favored over 9-1 No. 3 Oregon...don't be. Utah has played the toughest schedule and has slight edges in ypp margin (No. 20 vs No. 21) and ypg margin (No. 28 vs No. 32). Oregon did win outright in their two underdog roles this year (at Ohio St and at UCLA) so they won't be overly intimidated here. We were hoping to bet Utah here but we think this line was sharp. Note Utah games are 8-2 to the OVER this year.

Washington 25 COLORADO 20. Washington has fired head coach Jimmy Lake less than two years on the job. He was already suspended for last week's game vs Arizona St. The Huskies are just 3-7 ATS this season and one of the main reasons was poor recruiting which was supposed to be Lake's specialty. They're stepping down in class here vs a Colorado team that is No. 118 in ypp margin and No. 126 in ypg margin. We didn't get involved but would certainly lean with Colorado if the line went to +7.

NOTRE DAME 38 Georgia Tech 20. Don't look now but Notre Dame sits at 9-1 and there is a path for them to make the playoff for the 3rd time in 4 years. Since the loss to Cincinnati, Notre Dame is 5-0 SU and 5-0 ATS. They took advantage of a Virginia team playing without their starting QB last week and the Irish dominated. Now they're taking on a Georgia Tech team that is just 1-5 SU and 1-5 ATS in their last 6 games and close the season with NF and No. 1 Georgia. We're guessing head coach Geoff Collins will get another season but his tenure has been a disappointment so far. We lean with ND.

California 25 STANFORD 22. This is an intriguing handicap as you have a Cal team that saw the first FBS game in 2021 be postponed due to COVID as their game last week vs USC was rescheduled until December 4th. In their last game, a very short-handed Cal team lost to Arizona 10-3. It is expected they get everyone back here. On the other side, it appears that Stanford will get back Tanner McKeen at QB here after he's missed the last two games...a pair of blowout losses for Stanford. Stanford is on a 10-1 SU and 8-3 ATS run in the Big Game. However, we lean with Cal here.

Arizona St 29 OREGON ST 28. Oregon St is bowl eligible for the first time since 2013. Did they celebrate or are there bigger goals for them? Meanwhile, Arizona St rallied for a 35-30 win at Washington last week. Statistically, the Sun Devils are impressive with a No. 8 yards per play margin (+1.67) in the country (Oregon St is No. 40). The Beavers have done better in the underdog role this year winning outright their last two times. We'll take +3 and hope for a "+3.5" to show in the market.

3★ UCLA 34 USC 28. We like UCLA here. The Bruins felt they should have won last year's game losing in the final seconds. They are the better team statistically (No. 66 vs No. 86 in ypp play). USC has failed to cover the spread in their last 4 games as they are winding down the season with an interim. They recently lost their best player WR Drake London to injury. The Trojans will be starting a true freshman at QB in Jaxson Dart. The homefield edge isn't that big of a deal between cross-town rivals.

East Carolina 26 NAVY 24. Decent spot for Navy here who comes off a bye and playing in their final home game. The Midshipmen are on a 17-1 SU run on Senior Day with the only loss coming last year in front of no fans. They catch East Carolina off an upset of Memphis in which the Pirates got to bowl eligibility for the first time since 2014. Did they celebrate all week? ECU's 6-game ATS win streak may come to an end here.

Auburn 28 SOUTH CAROLINA 19. Obviously, the major story here is that Auburn QB Bo Nix will be out for the rest of the season with an ankle injury. TJ Finley will get the start here. On top of that, Auburn also lost their kicker for the season. Last week, the Tigers blew a 28-3 lead to Mississippi St, the biggest blown lead in school history. They're taking on a South Carolina team desperately trying to get to bowl eligibility. The Gamecocks disappointed last week falling at Missouri. Nix gets a lot of grief from fans, we'll see how much he is worth here (we downgraded Auburn 4 points).

TULSA 37 Temple 15. It's not been a good look for Temple recently as the Owls are on a 0-5 SU and 0-5 ATS run. Meanwhile, Tulsa has covered two straight and need to win out to get to bowl eligibility. Tulsa is a respectable No. 62 in ypp margin despite playing a tough schedule that has featured 3 Top 10 teams (Oklahoma St, Ohio St and Cincinnati).

Appalachian St 31 TROY 21. We lost fading Appalachian St on these pages last week. It was a horrific beat (see page 1). The Mountaineers are No. 23 in ypp margin and have now won and covered 4 straight. Troy is sitting on 5-5 and probably needs to win one of their final 2 games to save their head coach's job. We were hoping to catch a bigger number with Troy.

2★ UNDER 64.5 OLE MISS 47 Vanderbilt 13. We're not sure this is a good spot to lay 36.5 points. Ole Miss is off a huge home win over Texas A&M with a rare visit from ESPN's *College Gameday*. They have the Egg Bowl on deck in 5 days. Is QB Matt Corral going to play a full game? Vanderbilt has covered their last two games as a big dog. We also like UNDER. Everyone thinks high-scoring with Ole Miss but their games have gone UNDER the total in 5 straight. Meanwhile, Vanderbilt games are 4-1 to the UNDER recently. Vanderbilt games average 50 total ppg on the season, Ole Miss 63. Why is this total 64.5?

MIDDLE TENNESSEE 27 Old Dominion 25. ODU is one of the biggest surprises in CFB this year. After going 1-11 in 2019, not playing in 2020 and having a first-time head coach, they have won and covered 3 straight (7-3 ATS on season) and are still hoping for a bowl game. Middle also needs one win to get to bowl eligibility. Remember MT is still down to a 3rd string QB. Something the market may be forgetting this week after they blew out a hapless FIU team last week.

ALABAMA 38 Arkansas 18. When you start looking up and down Alabama's schedule, there's not a lot of high-quality wins outside the Mississippi schools. While Alabama is No. 1 in ypp margin, No. 2 in scoring margin and No. 5 in ypp margin, Three of their games have come against FCS Mercer, Southern Miss (bottom 5 FBS team) and last week vs another bottom 5 FBS team in New Mexico St. Arkansas has played the tougher schedule and the Hogs are a respectable No. 28 in ypp margin. We were fortunate to win with them last week in OT over LSU.

LSU 45 UL-Monroe 14. We faded LSU on these pages last week and actually came away impressed as they probably should have won and covered vs Arkansas but fell in OT. Our numbers actually like them here. The problem is how motivated can LSU really be to get margin in what is a lost season playing with an interim? ULM has received a ton of money in the market the last couple of weeks, but they are on a 0-3 ATS run.

TULANE 33 South Florida 27. Tulane is only 1-9 SU but they have not given up on the season. They covered vs Cincinnati and UCF and lost in OT to Tulsa last week. They're taking a step down in class here vs a USF team that impressed us last week in their cover vs Cincinnati. Keep an eye on USF freshman QB Timmy McClain who is going to be a really good player for the Bulls down the line. Our power ratings have this one pegged exactly on the number (see page 7).

OKLAHOMA 33 Iowa St 27. Both teams have been incredibly disappointing this year. Iowa St is just 6-4 on the season despite ranking No. 10 in ypp margin (+128.5) and No. 11 in ypp margin (+1.58). Oklahoma is 9-1 but we've downgraded the Sooners 10-points in our power ratings. Last week's loss to Baylor was the worst offensive performance of the entire Lincoln Riley era. Iowa St is on a 5-1 ATS run vs Oklahoma but our numbers say OU is the play.

TCU 42 Kansas 20. Tough game to be involved in. On one hand you have Kansas coming off the huge upset over Texas which ended their 56-game Big 12 road losing streak. Were they celebrating all week? On the other hand, TCU was throttled by Oklahoma St last week. Did TCU just have the one-game bump with an interim and are now just playing out the season? We did take the UNDER as there seems to be an over-reaction to last week's finals.

KENTUCKY 46 New Mexico St 12. Brutal spot for New Mexico St on back-to-back road after playing physical Alabama last week. Meanwhile, the Wildcats led Vanderbilt 31-3 at halftime but couldn't cover the spread. That's 3 straight spread losses for them. Our numbers like the UNDER as we bet UNDER 62.5 on Sunday.

Marshall 36 CHARLOTTE 24. Marshall lost an importance conference home game to UAB last week and have another big one vs WKU on deck. They Herd haven't been great as a favorite losing outright 3 times. Still, they are No. 15 in ypp margin while Charlotte is No. 110. We took UNDER 64.5 on the Sunday openers.

UTSA 30 Uab 24. Both teams control their own destiny in the CUSA West division. UTSA is 10-0 on the season but UAB has the better ypp margin at No. 109 (+1.39) while UTSA is No. 31 (+1.05). UAB as a program is also used to playing in bigger games including a road upset at Marshall last week. It was clear UTSA was looking ahead after they struggled with lowly Southern Miss last week. Our numbers lean UTSA here.

Oklahoma St 35 TEXAS TECH 24. Oklahoma St is the hottest ATS team in the country with 8 straight covers! The Cowboys are now up to No. 6 in our power ratings. Their defense is legit ranking No. 3 in ypp allowed (276.6), No. 8 in scoring (16.4) and No. 7 in yards per play allowed (4.47). They are also +24 in the sack differential category. Meanwhile, Texas Tech comes in off the dramatic win over Iowa St that clinched bowl eligibility. Jonathan Garibay kicked a 62-yard field goal as time expired. It broke the Texas Tech record of 57 yards by Blade Adams against Texas A&M in 1977. We bet OVER 54.5 as Oklahoma St needs style points.

Baylor 26 KANSAS ST 25. How will Baylor handle success? They're coming off one of their biggest wins taking down Oklahoma 27-14. They're taking on a red-hot Kansas St team that has won 4 straight and covered 3 straight. We were expecting to bet Kansas St here but were hoping for a "+4" sign. We are a little surprised Kansas St is the favorite. Baylor is No. 9 in the country in ypp margin. We're passing for now.

GEORGIA ST 39 Arkansas St 23. Georgia St is one of the hottest teams in the country with 5 straight ATS covers. Last week, they pulled the upset at Coastal Carolina as 12.5-point underdogs. They're taking on a Arkansas St team that found themselves underdogs to ULM last week but won outright. Arkansas St's defense is really bad but the UNDER has cashed in 5 straight games for them. That's where our lean is.

UTEP 30 Rice 22. Rice is just 2-8 ATS on the season. Still, they've competed better as of late and put up 500-plus yards of offense at WKU last week. After clinching bowl eligibility, UTEP has lost 3 straight. Still they have a huge ypp margin edge here (No. 39 vs No. 120) but hte Miners have played the much easier schedule (No. 139 in Sagarin strength of schedule vs Rice's No. 82). We lean OVER.

Byu 38 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 18. BYU comes in off a bye. We've been more impressed with BYU this season than last year's team that finished 11-1 as the Cougars have played a much tougher schedule. They are No. 32 in ypp margin while Georgia Southern is No. 115. We were hoping to bet BYU here but the line came higher than expected. We do lean UNDER.

North Texas 34 FIU 23. These are two teams heading in opposite directions. North Texas has covered 4 straight and won 3 straight as they still have bowl hopes. There will be no bowl for FIU who is a pitiful 1-9 SU and 3-7 ATS. Coach Butch Davis will not return in 2022. "This year has been a nightmare," Davis told The Action Network. "You can imagine the players' reaction when a head coach's job was posted online. The administration has been sabotaging the program. Their decision to post the job has resulted in a major negative impact on the football program and our ability to recruit and retain players." North Texas -7 was one of our favorite bets we made on the Sunday openers.

UTAH ST 29 Wyoming 23. We're a little surprised the market is betting against Utah St again this week. They have covered 4 straight and are coming off a 35-point cover at San Jose St last week. The Aggies were 50/1 to win the Mountain West in the preseason but they are on track to get to the Mountain West championship game. Wyoming still needs one more win to get to bowl eligibility. They got a miracle cover vs Boise St last week (see page 1) but were the right side for most of the game.

Colorado St 28 HAWAII 24. Colorado St's season seems to have went down the drain in the final seconds vs Utah St last month as the Rams are now on a 0-4 SU/ATS run. However, we bet numbers not teams and took them at "Pick" on Sunday. We saw Hawaii in person last Saturday and came away unimpressed. They were manhandled at the line of scrimmage vs UNLV losing a best bet on these pages. Colorado St is also a physical team on both sides of the line of scrimmage and should have success here.

Tuesday, November 23rd

There's no lines on these games yet but since our newsletter won't come out until next Wednesday, here are some quick thoughts.

BALL ST 33 Buffalo 27. As of press-time we are yet to know how Ball St fared vs Central Michigan and how Buffalo fared vs Northern Illinois as both games were played Wednesday night. It's a rematch of last year's MAC Championship game but both teams have disappointed this season. Ball St is just 3-7 ATS and Buffalo is just 1-5-1 ATS in their last 7.

Western Michigan 32 NORTHERN ILLINOIS 31. As of press-time it is unknown how NIU fared vs Buffalo as the Huskies could be closing in on a division championship. WMU is on a 0-4 ATS run and the Broncos have already lost outright as a favorite 4 times in MAC play. Will they be favored here and will they be playing spoiler to NIU?

For the past five seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 373-302-12 (55%) including an outstanding 71-50 (59%) last year! Last week's plays went 5-1 and are 42-44 on the season.** That's still pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Rice +9.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Sunday, November 19th

CLEVELAND 25 Detroit 16. Detroit's losing streak is OVER! Well kind of as the Lions tied the Steelers last week. At least they won't become the first 0-17 team. The Lions did rush for a season high 229 yards as Dan Campbell took over the play-calling. Cleveland has been the bigger disappointment this season at 5-5 and off a blowout loss at New England. The Browns have been high-variance all season and we don't trust them laying this kind of number vs anyone right now. We lean Detroit (check status of QB Jared Goff as he isn't practicing today) but prefer the UNDER.

San Francisco 25 JACKSONVILLE 20. Not a good spot here for the 49ers traveling across the country on a short week after playing on MNF and it's an early start time. Last week was San Francisco's best performance of the season by far as they beat the Rams comfortably as 3.5-point underdogs. However, they're laying a TD on the road to a Jacksonville team that is getting better at 2-2 SU and 3-1 ATS in their last 4 games. Lean Jags.

2★ OVER 50 BUFFALO 31 Indianapolis 23. A rematch of last year's playoff game that saw the Bills win 27-24. Buffalo rebounded from their loss to Jacksonville by destroying the Jets last week. That's now 6 wins by at least 15 points this season. Meanwhile, Indianapolis is a solid 5-2 in their last 7 games with only losses coming to Baltimore and Tennessee in OT. Indianapolis has scored at least 23 points in 7 straight games. Weather doesn't look like it will be a factor. We like the OVER.

Miami 24 N.Y. JETS 20. Just announced on Wednesday morning Joe Flacco will get the start for the Jets. It's actually been the defense that has been the biggest issue for them allowing 44 ppg the last 4 games as they are only 2-7 ATS. Meanwhile, the Dolphins have extra time to prep coming off a Thursday game. Miami has won back-to-back games and last week their defense held Baltimore to just 94 rushing yards. That was the 2nd fewest for the Ravens in 4 years! The Dolphins are on a 6-1 SU and 6-0-1 ATS run in the series. Another here.

CAROLINA 24 Washington 20. Cam Newton will start here for the Panthers. Yes, you read that right. In 2021, Newton will be your Carolina starting QB. Ron Rivera also returns to Carolina where he was the coach of the Panthers from 2011-2019. Both teams come in off shocking upsets. The Football team was just 1-7 ATS but beat Tampa Bay 29-19 as 9.5-point underdogs. Meanwhile, Carolina took advantage of a short-handed Arizona team and won 34-10 as 7-point underdogs. Cam Newton ran for a TD on his first touch and threw for a score on his second touch, hence why he's getting the start here. It also helps having a healthy Christian McCaffrey. We don't expect to be involved here.

Baltimore 25 CHICAGO 19. Baltimore is off one of their worst performances in recent memory losing outright to the Dolphins as 8.5-point favorites. Oh wait, they got beat 41-17 at home to Cincinnati as 6.5-point favorites just a few weeks ago. What is wrong with this team? The Bears come in off a bye after their controversial loss to the Steelers on MNF. Baltimore is just 1-6 ATS as a favorite this year losing outright 3 times. Not sure if they lose here, but we don't want to lay 6.

New Orleans 22 PHILADELPHIA 21. Every single week the Eagles take money in the market place. Last week that money cashed as they beat the Broncos 30-13 on the road. They started the week off as underdogs but the line closed "Pick". Now they take on a desperate New Orleans team off back-to-back close losses. We did cash with them on these pages last week as their 2-point conversion attempt was unsuccessful in the loss to the Titans. Philly is 0-4 at home this year. We lean New Orleans here but wait later in the week for a possible better number.

3★ Houston (plus the points) Tennessee 26 HOUSTON 20. Tennessee is 5-0 SU and 5-0 ATS as an underdog this season. The Titans are just 3-2 SU and 2-3 ATS as a favorite. Considering Tennessee is playing an 11th straight week, have a league-high 20 players on IR and have a huge game vs New England on deck, we question their motivation for margin here. Meanwhile, Houston comes in off a bye and Tyrod Taylor is back at QB. He is a significant upgrade over Davis Mills. We like Houston here.

Green Bay 24 MINNESOTA 22. Green Bay has covered 9 straight games since that disastrous season opening blowout loss to the Saints. 9 straight in the NFL is almost unheard of! They welcomed back Aaron Rodgers last week after the COVID drama but it was the Packers defense that remains under-valued in the market as they shutout the Seahawks. Minnesota is off a big-win vs the Chargers to keep their playoff hopes alive. We lean UNDER here which has gone 7-0 in Green Bay's last 7 games. Minnesota is a great teaser option up to +8.5.

Cincinnati 25 LAS VEGAS 24. We think the wheels are starting to fall off for this Raiders team. Just too many distractions to overcome for this team. After getting crushed by the Chiefs on SNF, that's back-to-back terrible performances after their bye week. Speaking of bye weeks, Cincinnati needed one after losing to the lowly Jets and getting crushed by Cleveland. We don't expect to be involved here.

SEATTLE 24 Arizona 23. With Arizona favored by 2.5 here, the expectation is that Kyler Murray will return after missing the last couple of games. Last week Arizona was humiliated by the Panthers 34-10 as 7-point home favorites. Meanwhile, the Seahawks were shut-out by the Packers in Russell Wilson's return to the lineup. Wilson was just 20 of 40 for 161 yards and 2 INT's as the Seahawks were shutout for the first time since 2011...back when Wilson was QB for Wisconsin! Seattle is in their preferred underdog role (14-6 ATS last 20) and are in desperation mode at 3-6 SU. Even if Murray returns, he could be rusty.

KANSAS CITY 30 Dallas 27. Dallas scored too many points in the first half vs Atlanta last week (led 36-3). Blowouts tend to have very slow paces in the second half and that was the case as we lost the UNDER. It was an impressive performance for the Cowboys who are now 8-1 ATS. Meanwhile, KC is off their best performance of the season, a blowout of the Raiders on SNF. They've won 3 straight but still are only 3-7 ATS on the year. Popcorn game for us as we don't see too much value.

2★ UNDER 47 L.A. CHARGERS 25 Pittsburgh 19. Can we switch this game with Dallas/Kansas City as the SNF game? Mason Rudolph looks like he will get the start here for the Steelers who are off a tie vs Detroit last week. When it's Detroit, that is basically a loss. The Steelers are in their preferred away dog role but that is with Big Ben under center. They're taking on a Chargers team that needs to rebound after getting upset by the Vikings last week. We're taking the UNDER which is 38-12-1 in Pittsburgh's last 51 away games including 3-0 this year.

Monday, November 22nd

TAMPA BAY 30 N.Y. Giants 20. The Giants come in off a bye while Tampa is off back-to-back losses. The Bucs are now 0-5 ATS away from home this season after losing outright to Washington last week. These two met last year on MNF and the Giants covered as 12.5-point home dogs in a 25-23 loss (missed a late 2-point conversion). The Giants are on a 19-5 ATS run as a road underdog.
