BLUE MOON

According to NASA’s Gordon Johnston—the third full moon in a season that has four full moons is a blue moon by the older definition of this term dating back to 1528. Sometime in the 1940s, people started using ‘blue moon’ to refer to the second full moon in a calendar month.

The August full moon’s nickname is the Sturgeon Moon after the fish that was once abundant in North American lakes and rivers. Today this is one of the rarest fish. It is listed as threatened or endangered in 19 of the 20 US states it is found in due to intense overfishing in the 19th century, pollution, and damage to their habitat.
