

ELORA SCULPTURE PROJECT – INSTALLATION GUIDELINES – SMALL SCALE SITES

All sculptures must be securely fastened to the permanent base.

The base consists of a 6" diameter concrete pier at ground level and 3 threaded rods of 3/8". The 3 rods are placed in a triangular pattern 3.5" between each, center to center.

Your sculpture should have a plate of steel, or other suitable material, to connect to the rods. This can be integral to the sculpture, or a platform or pedestal that the sculpture will be securely attached to.

Holes in your plate should be larger than 3/8"; we recommend 5/8" to 3/4".

The foot print of your sculpture or pedestal can be any shape or size up to 12" x 12".

Typically, one set of nuts and washers is used below to level your plate and another set to secure it from the top. Hardware is provided for you.

These details apply to small scale sites only #9 and #11.

Artists are encouraged to visit their assigned site to determine the best orientation, etc.
