Admission Procedures

1. Submit an enrollment application for admission and the \$30 application fee.
2. Submit a copy of your valid photo I.D. (i.e.: driver's license, passport, military ID, state issued ID, etc.)
3. Submit your social security card (we will make a photocopy of the original).
4. Submit a copy of your high school diploma or G. E. D. certificate.
5. Submit a copy of academic transcripts to be evaluated for credit.
6. Submit ACT score report or take the Wonderlic test (no additional testing fee required - if needed, up to three attempts are paid through the application fee).
8. If Title IV student loans are received, Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note must be completed. *visit www.StudentLoans.gov*
9. Submit shot records, TB skin test and proof of Hepatitis B vaccine start of series or sign waiver prior to admission.

Admission Requirements for Cosmetology Program

High school diploma or GED required

Meet the minimum required score on an entrance exam:

Wonderlic: A minimum score of a 10th grade level is required

ACT: subscore requirements are Reading – 13; Math – 14; Language - 13

Submit 2 headshot photographs (1 Submitted to the State Board)

Cosmetology Program Objectives

This program is designed to train and produce students who will be sufficiently knowledgeable and capable of finding employment in the beauty industry. The students should be able to function effectively in one of the many specialty areas such as: hair Stylist, Hair Colorist, Manicurist, and make-up Artist or as a Beauty Salon Owner, Cosmetology instructor, Supervisor, Director, or School Owner. Opportunities for employment occur in independently owned or large chain beauty salons, resort hotels, cruise ships, motion picture or television studios, and cosmetic firms. The goal of the program is to maximize the development and personal growth of each student as a total person; to help each student discover his or her own potential and function as cosmetology entrepreneur.
