1 WILLIAMSBURG, VIRGINIA

2 COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG

Today, we step back into the 18th-century as we tour the restored area of Colonial Williamsburg consisting of more than 500 restored and reconstructed homes, shops, taverns and government buildings, all dressed in the traditional holiday decorations of the period. Hundreds of costumed townspeople recreate the daily life of this gracious city. A Holiday Dinner is included this evening. Colonial Williamsburg's Grand Illumination celebrates the winter holidays. Musical performances on multiple stages and fireworks launched from three locations usher in the season with a bang. On Sunday the Grand Illumination begins with the roar of a cannon to signal the occupants to illuminate their windows by lighting hundreds of candles throughout the village. Many activities are scheduled during the Grand Illumination and we will be a part of the happy crowd sharing in the celebration. The "simple fresh greenery" has evolved into elaborate decorations that are hand-made from fresh fruits, vegetables, and evergreens adorning doors, windows, fences, lamp posts, and transoms. The month of December is full of fine food, music, laughter, and a true sense of magic. It may not be the way the holiday was celebrated in colonial America, but the Christmas season in Williamsburg has evolved into a tradition recognized all across America. **D**
