It was also discussed that there will be a tree planting at the Community School on Arbor Day April 24, the city will buy the tree for the school, type of tree to be determined. Mayor Jiampetti discussed that Parks & Playgrounds would provide a tree to be planted at the playground on Buffalo Ave.

We will have a table at the ACUA Earth Day on Sun April 26, we will giveaway a plant, herb etc. which will be grown by Spragg School students, to be coordinated by Alysha Garcia.

We will participate in Community Clean Up Day on May 2, as well as Hometown Celebration.
