In our first year at Lakeside, the ASC Education Department had no idea what to expect. With a limited rehearsal schedule and no idea of how many students would be brave enough to come and play with us, producing a full-length work did not seem like the best way to set the LHS students up for success. The solution that we came up with was to allow, largely, the students to drive the artistic decisions as to what scenes and monologues would be included in this "greatest hits" performance that you are about to see. If a student had a strong pulled towards a specific play or character, they have been afforded the opportunity to explore that text. The framing device wherein two students are lost afterhours in the Shakespeare wing of a wax museum was conceived entirely by our actors through a facilitated discussion with the directing team, and the words in those scenes are almost entirely their own.

We have invited them to take huge risks by presenting these monologues and scenes—full of heightened language and emotionally-charged characters—out-of-context, all the while looking directly into the eyes of the audience (as Shakespeare's actors did). Because of this direct-address performance style, you are now as much a part of these students' creative process as the young actors onstage!

Thank you so much to Greta, Chris, Lisa, Becky and the entire faculty & staff of Lakeside High School as well as the LHS Drama Association for extending the invitation for us to join you as artists-in-residence this Fall. It has truly been a pleasure, and we look forward to continuing this wonderful creative partnership in the years to come. It has been a pleasure working with such talented and enthusiastic young people.
