DESCRIPTION: Established in 1959 Bingham Projects has been the leading supplier of traditional archery bowyer materials, including a variety of bow kits. I use a number of Bingham materials in my bow restoration project. This is a Bingham Classic recurve that was made from a Bingham bow kit. Walnut and Birdseye Maple riser. Low wrist grip. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing or stress cracks; A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Comes with a new string and the new Bear hair rest and side plate shown.

Note: The string grooves on the bottom limb are similar to the grooves on the top limb. The string may not fit perfectly into the bottom grooves, depending on the size of the string loops since a regular bottom string loop is generally not as big as the top loop (see pic on last page).
