

AN ORDINANCE TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH BY ADOPTING AN ELECTRICAL CODE, PRESCRIBING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS IN THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA, AND FIXING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Adoption of Electrical Code. The installation, use and repair of all electrical wiring and all fixtures and appliances using electricity, within the City of Rolla, shall be in accordance with the minimum standards as set forth in the laws, regulations and wiring standards of the North Dakota Century Code, as last amended or revised, and as published by the State Electrical Board of the State of North Dakota, a certified copy of which publication shall be placed on file in the office of the City Auditor, and which wiring standards are hereby adopted by reference

Section 2. Penalties. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance or any of the laws, regulations and standards hereby adopted, shall upon conviction be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court; the Court to have power to suspend said sentence and to revoke the suspension thereof.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and take effect immediately upon its final passage and the publication of its title and penalty clause.
