A True Tale of a First Generation Italian-American

He was born on June 21, 1917 to Italian immigrants. His parents were born in San Salvadore Telisino in the Province of Benevento a town outside of Naples. His name was Michele or Michael Votto. Because he was the son of Italians who immigrated and who only spoke their native language, Michael only spoke Italian when he first went to school. He then learned to speak English in school to acclimate to our society. Coming from an entire Italian speaking home, this was certainly difficult as it was for many Italian immigrants of the day.

When America entered World War II, Michael enlisted in the army for his country. At first he was stationed in Northern Africa, seeing limited action. One of the many stories he told was of the time he had to “frisk” a German General. He then was sent to southern Italy after the main forces had gone before him liberating the Italian people from Mussolini. Michael got to see many of his Italian relatives while stationed in Italy. One of the first jobs he had was that he worked in an Italian factory, hiring local Italians to work there. One of Michael’s advantages was that he spoke both English and Italian. He was then asked to translate Italian to English for an Italian General. He did so until the end of the war.

Because Michael was a first generation Italian-American whose parents immigrated from Italy, Michael was able to do an important job for the United States during World War II. Michel Votto was the father and grandfather of Lodge Members Janice Guido and Marybeth Madigan, and we are very proud of him.
