## Purple Worship Booklet Bags (65 bags are needed for walk)

## Instructions

This is just one version of planning and making the booklet bags. There are other sewing patterns, but this one is pretty simple.

## Cutting 10" $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$ fabric for Booklet Bags

This diagram is for fabric that comes in $44^{\prime \prime}$ width, shown below folded in half for a $22^{\prime \prime}$ width. The picture represents one yard of fabric. I use a rotary cutter.


1 Keep the fabric folded in half.
2 Cut the fabric into 12 inch strips.
3 Leaving the fabric folded, cut across each strip at the fold.
4 Then cut across the strip at 10 inches and 20 inches.
5 Cutting the fabric in this fashion, you can get fabric for 4 bags per strip, resulting in 12 bags per yard of fabric.
6 For each Walk's bags, you will need approximately 6 to 7 yards of fabric.
(you will have extra for mistakes that might happen.)
7 You will also need approximately 45 yards of ribbon ( $65+$ ribbons at $24^{\prime \prime}$ each) for the closure. ( $\frac{1}{4}$ inch ribbon is available in 20 yard rolls at craft stores)

## Sewing $10^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ fabric to cr eate Book let B ags

This diagram is for a booklet bag that begins with $10 \times 12$ inch fabric.


1 Iron $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ over at each end - wrong sides together. (underside of fabric)
2 Iron 1" over from the top - wrong sides together (underside of fabric)
3 Place 24" of ribbon inside the folded portion and sew $\frac{3}{4}$ inch seam lengthwise (encasing ribbon)
4 Fold fabric in half with right sides together (top of fabric)
5 Sew $\frac{1}{2}$ inch seam across the bottom and $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam up the side to just below the ribbon casing.
6 Turn bag right-side out
7 Tie ends of ribbons together (may want to add bead or other decorative item)
8 Optional: Decorate front of bag
