LBVCA's ANNUAL FALL CLEAN-UP October 8-11, 2014 (Wednesday-Saturday)



LBVCA's Annual Fall Clean-Up will once again coincide with Benton County's Fall Clean Up. To volunteer for the LBVCA Clean-Up call Debby Maule (359-3927) or the LBVCA Office (359-3204). Thank you, volunteers!

We encourage all able residents to haul their own clean-up items directly to Benton County's Wimpy Jones Road location (behind the NEBCO fire station) from 7:00 a.m. to noon, Saturday, October 11th. **Or**, you may bring your items to the designated Clean-Up area at the **LBV Airstrip** from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday through Friday, 10/8-10/10. There will <u>not</u> be a "swap" area this year; everything brought to the Airstrip will go in the dumpster (except electronics and/or hazardous* materials).

For those who need assistance, the Village hopes to have volunteers available for curb-side pickup on Wednesday-Friday, October 8th to October 10th, between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Call either Debby Maule (359-3927) or Marty at the LBV Office (359-3204) to schedule a pick up. (Please plan ahead to have your items set out on your driveway.)

FEES: Curbside pick-up: \$10-\$20 (depending on quantity of items). Pay by cash or check. Airstrip drop-off: \$5-\$20 (depending on quantity of items). Pay by cash or check.

IMPORTANT!

Once the dumpster at the Airstrip is full we'll be unable to accept any more household items. On Saturday, October 11th, our volunteers can't make any pickups as all efforts will be made to deliver everything to the Benton County clean-up site by noon that day.

*Hazardous materials, like automotive fluids, paint, all types of batteries, fluorescent bulbs, etc., will be collected at the Airstrip. Village volunteers will take the hazardous materials to the Benton County hazardous collection facility in Centerton.

What Benton County's Wimpy Jones location can accept:

- Batteries but no other hazardous material.
- Disposal of bulky items: furniture, mattresses and large plastic toys.
- Recycling of plastic bottles, paper, cardboard, and aluminum cans (no glass).
- Recycling of scrap metal: appliances, barbeque grills, swing sets, etc.
- *Pathfinders* will collect your foam packaging to turn into new products.
- *Habitat for Humanity* will accept donations of your useable bikes, lawn mowers, furniture, appliances, microwaves, televisions, and other household items.
- *Esco* will recycle electronics: televisions, computers, printers, and phones.
- *Benton County Solid Waste District* will recycle 4 passenger tires per family for free; a fee will be charged for more than 4 tires.

What LBV or Benton County's Wimpy Jones location will NOT accept:

- No household <u>trash</u> will be accepted.
- No construction or demolition waste including lumber, fixtures, tubs, sinks, doors, windows, mirrors or items containing glass will be accepted.
- No business or commercial waste will be accepted.
- No yard waste will be accepted.
- Residents with unacceptable items will not be allowed to unload unapproved items.
