

Writing a Check to Newcomers?

Our treasurer, Helen Hoppmann, has run into difficulty depositing checks as the bank has become very picky with how the checks are made out. If their computer can't read the check, it will not be accepted. Please follow the quidelines below:

- 1. Blue or Black Ink ONLY. Other colors are prettier, but the computers can't read them.
- 2. No corrections. Gone are the days when you could initial a correction. The bank will no longer accept a check with any corrections.
- Have a second check available just in case.

If an error is made, you will be asked to rewrite your check.
