Realizing this critical distinction, it is imperative to truly, fully understand, maintain and accordingly walk

truly get born again we receive the Holy Spirit in seed form. If we continue to follow the flesh we will	
"quench" and "grieve" the Holy Spirit (1 Thessalonians 5:19; Ephesians 4:30) and remain spiritual immature,	
in bondages, unfulfilled, devoid of revelation, and with very little, if any, Kingdom authority and power.	
However, to the extent we submit and are obedient to and led by the Holy Spirit we will be free, flourish and	
grow into being Kingdom "oaks of righteousness" (Isaiah 61:3), mighty men and women spiritual warriors,	
overcomers and sons of God.	

<u>It's a choice: Who will you be led by and live like – fallen Adam or perfected Jesus? To the extent you live like Adam, the devil will have his way with you; and to the extent you live like Jesus, God will have His way with you. Which way is up to you – choose daily, take up the serpent or the cross.</u>
