OLD BUSINESS

A. Presentation on behalf of Summerton Community Action Group— Mr. Robert McFadden briefly discussed that the "Scott's Branch School and the Summerton High School" is in the process of being placed on the National Parks Registry (ie. Brown vs. Board of Education Museum) and stated that once it is approved things will be moving pretty quickly. He stated that there is a library coming to Summerton and possibly a park, along with historical markers that are to be placed at several locations.

NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Amanda Salka stated that the Dropbox is back in place. Sercap, with GIS mapping, will be coming on the 18th to town to tour Summerton. We had a crew remove a tree on South Duke Street and will complete sewer issue at that location. We received all the funds on the Water, Sewer and Police Grants.

REPORT
