DESCRIPTION: The Mohawk was a high-end short hunting bow. Great looking and performing recurve. Rosewood and phenolic riser. Overlays on both the face and the back riser section. Original Indian brush rest. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes, chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. There appears to be a little bit of stress (or could be scratches) on the face limb above the sight window (see pic on last page). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow retailed new for \$80 back in the day, which translates to \$511 in 2020 inflation-adjusted dollars.
