### Minutes of Last Meeting

#### IH General Meeting International Harvester Collectors Club Iowa Chapter #5 Floyd, IA

September 3, 2017

- Call to Order- 7:20 pm President Brian Holdeman called the Chapter 5 General meeting to order. Directors present were Arland Jolly, Craig Wessels, Aaron Wade, Calvin Mennenga, Wayne Schoel, Gene Putz, Rod Richardson, Paul Schaffer and Treasurer Ray Cook.
- Secretary's Report Craig Wessels read the minutes from the April 1, 2017 meeting. Motion to approve the minutes by Bob Gihring 2nd by Jeff Eldridge. Motion Carried.
- Treasurer's Report Ray Cook- As of Aug. 2017 there was a beginning balance of \$133,119.55, income of \$13,600.00, expenses were \$8,402.68 for an ending balance of \$138,316.87. There is still some income and expenses to come yet from the RPRU. Ray gave a report of the income, expenses and profits from the RPRU so far. He told us that he needs to give the IRS a plan on what we plan to do with the profits from the show so we can maintain our 501c3 status. Motion to accept the report by Marlene Leinenweaver. 2nd by Joe Neville. Motion Carried.
- Newsletter and web site Report –Pam Olson-The deadline for the next newsletter will be Oct 15. If you have any ads or articles for the web site or the newsletter please get them to me so I can post them.
- National Board- Joe Neville- The National board wants to thank lowa for a great RPRU.
   Despite a few problems everything went off great. One of the main things we are working on now is trying to make it easier for the next group to do a RPRU show. In the next issue of Harvester Highlights we will have ballots for new board members, don't forget to vote.

- Merchandise Report- Bobbie Hammer- I would like to thank everyone who helped at the merchandise table at the RPRU. At our spring meeting we sold \$568. At RPRU we sold \$15.877.
- Membership Report- Karen Reiter- We currently have 633 active members. As of Aug I we have 54 members that have not renewed and are now inactive. If your phone number or address has changed please let me know.
- Scholarships Bob Gihring- This year we had 5
  memorial and 7 club scholarships to give out. Bob
  listed off all the recipients names and towns where
  they are from, 2 are here tonight, Madelynn Green
  and Matthew Lolwing each thanked the club and told
  us where they were egin to collere.
- 25th Aniversary- Denny Hammer- Denny read a few of the minutes and notes from the founding meetings. They listed all the challenges and problems with starting the club. They also listed all the original board members and advisers. Mariene Leinenweaver and Tom Johnson both stood up and told us some of there memories of starting the club and thanked everyone for continuing all their hard work. We had an anniversary party yesterday at the show grounds where we had a big sheet cake and lemonade for everyone.

- 2017 RPRU- Brian and Denny- We want to thank all the committee chairs for their hard work as well as all the others that help in any way. Without all your hard work we would not have had a great show. We had 652 exhibitors. We had 2500 total exhibits with over 1000 ractors. There was close to 40,000 in total attendance with close to 10,000 in paid attendance. We had a profit of over a \$100,000. The lowa State Fair was very impressed with our show and have already asked when we are coming back.
- 4-H Grants- Ray Cook- At our last meeting we thought we were not going to have enough time to get a program together for this year. After our April meeting a lot changed and we decided to go ahead with a program. We need to make a few changes for next year but this year turned out great, far better than the FFA program was. This year we gave out \$6.055 to the 4-H kids from lowa. Ray made a cardboard display showing all the winners and different categories, please take some time to look at it.
- Raffle Craig Wessels At our spring meeting we sold \$300. Our next place we sold tickets was RPRU there we sold \$4,000. In August we went to a Half Century of progress, a tractor show in Rantuol, Illinois, and sold \$1500. So far here this weekend we sold \$500. We are planning on taking it to the national toy show in Dyersville and selling some tickets.
- Fall Meeting- Our fall meeting will be in Avoca at Farmall Land Museum. The meal will be at 11:00 with meeting to follow. More information to come in our next newsletter.

- Director Search- Brian and Craig terms are up and cannot run again. Paul who filled Lynn's position, can run again. We have a few candidates lined up but could use some more.
