- Vehicle winter safety check,
- Cell phones to use to dial 911 to get help in an emergency,
- Collection and dispersal of warm winter clothing, and
- Distribution of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors to seniors as funds are available.

Basic Watercolor Painting with *Nancy Blatz*

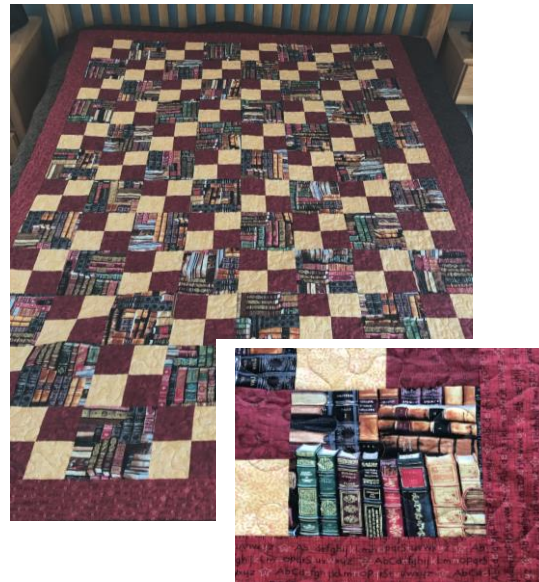

Hidden Wells Quilt

This quilt is made from strips that can be found in the depths of your stash or the fountains of fabrics at your favorite quilt store. The center measures 44" x 52" (with an 8½" block). This quilt is very adaptable by sewing more strips and changing sizes of the blocks and adding borders or not. This workshop is appropriate for all sewing skill levels.

New Ways with Triangles

Many quilt designs use half-square triangles. In this class we will use the tube method which eliminates the need to square the block once it is sewed – just sew, cut and press and the block is done.

Make a 20" square wall hanging or a 60" X 70" throw. Make it all half-square triangle blocks or add a medallion in the center. Use a background and one other color or many colors. Make it yours.

This is an INTERMEDIATE workshop.
