- take Interstate 5 Exit 95 located between Olympia and Centralia, WA
- drive West to the small town of Little Rock (about 3 miles). This is a very small community with an elementary school, church, post office and a Chevron gas station.
- between the church and the Chevron station the main road turns to the south. This becomes Little Rock Road SW.
- Continue heading south on Little Rock Road SW for about 1.6 miles and the gun club sign is on the left (East) side of the road.
