These are some of the things the Board accomplished this year:

- We completed the renovation of the swimming pool, which had significant leakage.
- We implemented a special assessment to cover the renovation cost of the swimming pool and tennis courts.
- A new roof was added to the rear of the clubhouse.
- Several windows and the doors were replaced in the clubhouse.
- All the wood picnic tables were powerwashed (thanks to Will Linne).
- The Dock area was cleaned up, and several trees were cut down.
- An HOA collection agency was contracted to assist with the problem of over \$40,000 in delinguent dues and assessments.

I would like to add here, that contrary to the rumors we have heard, special assessment funds have NOT been used on any repairs other than the pool. The special assessment money has only been used on pool repairs.

Upcoming issues facing the new Board are:

- We have had snow and ice damage to the pool over the winter, which will need to be fixed.
- We have to establish further procedures to collect on past due fees.
- We have to start on the tennis court repairs.
- We need to raise lot fees to meet expenses.

On closing this note, my wife and I deeply regret the passing of resident, Paula Price this month. We remember what a great Board president she was during and after the downburst that caused so much damage in the Community. She handled it all with incredible speed and effectiveness. We will miss her.
