

Paris Island Training Arena Etiquette

- Arena usage is "First Come First Served" unless reserved for exclusive use
 - o Do not enter arena when it is reserved for exclusive use
 - o If arena is reserved exclusively, it will be posted 24 hours in advance
- ➤ Do not mount or otherwise congregate in the entrance to the arena
- Mount & dismount in the center of the arena
- ➤ If you must stop, come to the center of the arena to do so
- ➤ Always be aware & think ahead!
 - Look where you're going and where others are going
- > Proper spacing is at least 2 horse-lengths from the horse in front of you
- "Outside" or "Rail" means closest to the rail or arena fence
- > "Inside" means closest to the center of the arena
- > Passing other riders:
 - o Faster horse takes the outside track
 - Slower horse takes the inside track walkers stay off the rail
 - o A rider may call out "rail" front rider should move to inside track
 - o If riding in opposite directions pass left shoulder to left shoulder
 - Do not crowd other riders
 - Do not cut off other riders
- ➤ If jumping, inform all other riders, beforehand, of your intent to jump
- ➤ If you lose control of your horse, warn other riders (i.e. yell "heads up!")
- ➤ Do not longe your horse in the arena please use the round training ring
- ➤ No reckless riding you will be asked to leave the arena
- ➤ No riding under the influence
- ➤ Remember be polite and forgiving we all make mistakes!
