THOROUGHBREDS HELPING THOROUGHBREDS HIGH POINT AWARD:

Thoroughbreds Helping Thoroughbreds (THT) champion and reserve champion awards will be awarded for the SIDC on SATURDAY only. To be eligible, horses must have a lip tattoo or a copy of their Jockey Club papers. Champion receives \$50 in cash, a hand-painted trophy, & a ch. ribbon; reserve receives \$10 cash & res. ribbon. Given to the one high score at any level for Saturday classes.

HIGH POINT RIBBON/AWARD provided by Barbara Wood, owner of New Hanover Farm, www.newhanoverfarm.com for both classical and western highest score and reserve for the entire show.

SIDC TOTAL SHOW HIGH POINT AWARD – sponsored by BJ Rubin/Classic Acres
LEDS logo saddle pads will be given to the ONE single high score of the two day SIDC at two levels: Junior High Point – under 16, Adult High Point - 16 and over.

FESTUS MEMORIAL HIGH POINT AQHA AWARD – sponsored by Mike Madigan
High point ribbon and trophy for one high score of the two day SIDC.
Copy of AQHA papers submitted with entry form. Western dressage is not included.

WESTERN DRESSAGE HIGH POINT AWARD – sponsored by K&M Pferdehof & WDAAL/TN/IL
Ribbon and Gift certificate for the highest Western Dressage Rider (gaited or non-gaited)

High Point Pony-Sponsored by Briar Bank Farm. High score for both days.

ENTRIES: Negative Coggins (1 yr.) required; include with entry. **Entries not accepted without a coggins in the envelope.** For out-of-state entrants who need an Illinois entry permit, call 217-782-4946.

FEES:

Class fees: \$20 each regular class for LEDA members. Class fees: \$25 each class for non-members.
Office fee: \$10 for LEDA members, \$20 for non-members
Late entry fee: \$25 (entry received after Sept. 10)

Membership dues for LEDA are \$25 senior/\$15 junior. Membership year runs September 1- August 31. Include membership dues with your entry, or pay online to ledaprez@yahoo.com. Membership form is located in the FILES section of the LEDA Facebook page.

STALLS:

Stalls: \$75/two nights, \$50/one night. **NO BEDDING IS INCLUDED WITH STALLS.**

Tack Stalls: \$40 two nights, \$25 one night

If working out of horse trailer (no stall): \$20 per day per horse/rider combo.

All stalls have full doors and are located in the Fairgrounds Show Barn with lighting, power, water.

Please bring hoses for wash racks.

GENERAL SHOW RULES:

One entry form per horse/rider combination PLEASE.

USEF HELMET RULE: Effective January 27, 2011, anyone mounted on a horse on competition grounds must wear protective headgear which includes non-competing riders, unless showing under Western Dressage Association of America Rules (all Western Dressage classes). Show Management also requires all riders under 18 years of age to wear protective headgear when mounted.

Western Dressage Tack: Tack must follow USEF WD rules regarding acceptable tack. This includes bits.

USEF WESTERN DRESSAGE RULES AND TESTS: See the Western Dressage Association of America website at www.westerndressageassociation.org.

All USDF/USEF rules apply in dressage classes except for the following:

Hoof boots in lieu of horseshoes are permitted.

Please dress neatly. Leather half chaps that look like tall boots are permitted.

Helmets with a safety harness are required. Safety vests are permitted in the show ring.

Horse/rider combinations are limited to a total of 2 rides per day on Saturday, 2 on Sunday.

ABSOLUTELY NO DRAW REINS or other devices, including ineligible bits, banned by USEF/USDF PERMITTED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS, including Friday night warmup. Rider will be eliminated from entire show if this occurs. There are no exceptions to this rule. If you are not sure what bits are permitted, please see rules at USEF.com

OTHER INFORMATION:

CLASS 1: Any tack, Western or English. Helmet required. Test located in FILES section of LEDA Facebook page

TEST OF CHOICE (TOC) CLASSES: PLEASE Specify test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Horse/rider combinations may enter each class more than once.

RIDE TIMES: Tentative schedule will be available on [the LEDA Facebook page](#) by September 17, 2019. Final schedule will be available at the show. Be sure to check your ride times.

ARENAS: Dressage arena covered with sand footing. Two sand warm-ups (outdoors) and under pavilion front entrance.

DOGS: Must be leashed at all times. We prefer that you leave your pets at home, if possible. Thank you.

PARKING: No parking allowed next to barn. All vehicles must park in designated lot across from barn. Violators subject to tow by fairgrounds personnel.

CAMPERS: Hookups available from fairgrounds operators. Please call Du Quoin Security at 618-542-0474 once you have arrived at the show grounds.

LODGING: Group rate available at Fairgrounds Inn (call 888-542-5001 or 618-542-5000 or visit www.fairgroundsin.com). Please mention the Southern Illinois Dressage Classic Horse Show.

DIRECTIONS: From North/South I-57: Take Exit #71, Rt. 14, west toward Du Quoin for approx. 15 miles. Turn right on US Hwy. 51 and immediately look for the Coca Cola Bottling plant on the right. Just past the bottling plant, look for a sign for Tracy Lane (just before a "Family Restaurant" on the corner). Turn right onto Tracy Lane and follow it one block to the barn on the right.

From West/East I-64: Turn south onto US Hwy. 51 and follow through Du Quoin (approx. 31 miles). Turn left onto Tracy Lane just past the Family Restaurant and follow it one block to the barn on the right. If you pass Rt. 14, you have gone too far.
