## Special Offering - June 9 Cataract Surgery for Pr. Julio's Wife

Pastor Julio's wife, Mirna, needs surgery to have her cataracts removed. The doctors say she runs the risk of going blind without the surgery, which will cost them \$2,900. There is a history of serious eye problems in Mirna's family. You may recall that Grace provided financial support for Pastor Julio when his daughter had to have eye surgery just a few years ago. There will be a special offering on Sunday, June 9th to help raise money for Mirna's surgery. Pastor Julio's three other sister churches are also providing financial assistance. Grace has committed to offsetting a fourth of the cost, or \$725, and Council has provided \$500 to get us started. Any funds received in the special offering over and above \$725 will be allocated to future El Salvador initiatives. Thank you in advance for your support!
