COACHES CHARTER

Clarbeston Road AFC Coaches commit to:

- 1. Meet the required standards of personal conduct at all times
- 2. Have regard for the health safety and wellbeing of team members at all times
- 3. Ongoing personal development to maintain the required qualifications and to ensure all players receive good quality coaching and development opportunities
- 4. Prepare in advance for coaching sessions and matches, to arrive promptly/in time to set up and to ensure junior players are properly supervised when under their supervision
- 5. Collect subscriptions, training fees and fundraising contributions (as appropriate) and to provide such funds to the Treasurer without undue delay
- 6. Collect fines from players (as appropriate) if necessary excluding players from selection if fines are not paid within 1 calendar month of becoming due (subject to ratification)
- 7. Support and participate in fund raising activities and events and to promote these to players/parents to maximise income to support the running and development of Clarbeston Road AFC
- 8. Promptly refer any complaints or examples of unacceptable conduct to the relevant Club Secretary for consideration by the Committee
- 9. Promptly refer any child welfare issues to the Club Welfare Officer for advice/action $\,$
- 10. Attend Coaches Forum meetings to support delivery of good quality coaching to team members
