Please remind yourself to hydrate before you even launch your boat and it is suggested by pros that you drink three bottles of water at that time. NEW BUSINESS AND REMINDERS

The motion to allow club members who are not fishing a club tournament to be held on a specific Cape Coral body of water to fish said body of water the week prior to the tournament was voted on at last week's meeting and did not pass. The rule that club members are prohibited from fishing a Cape Coral body of water that a club tournament will be held for a week prior to the event remains in effect.

Remember that the pay ramp at Kennedy Chain is now using an electronic payment system. You must either download the app to your phone or register with the service at **passport parking** which is available both iPhone and Android versions to submit payment for parking at the ramp. If you can't access the site for whatever reason, you can call 239-424-9459 and register to park that day. The app requires a location code. For the BMX ramp, the site code is **1960**. This will be in effect at our next open tournament on June 15th.
