## ~COMMANDER~

In July, the Annual Car, Truck, and Bike Show was hosted by our Auxiliary, Honor Guard, and Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 1117. The show was a great success thanks to the 73 vehicle entries and the many local businesses donating door prizes. We would also like to thank all the volunteers for their hard work.

I also want to recognize and thank our Canteen Manager, members, and Post Officers for donating their labor to put a new coat of paint on our canteens' exterior. Since becoming the Post Commander, I believe it was important to focus on facility maintenance and exterior improvements to our Post. Now, as the end of summer nears, we still plan to continue making exterior improvements before it gets cold. We hope to get the parking lot sealed and have the furnace, A/C unit that heats and cools the southern portion of our building replaced. These improvements are made possible; thanks to the donations received from our associated organizations, the funds generated from our 50/50 drawings and the steadily improving canteen participation rates. Our goal is to complete both projects before the end of October.

Our improving financial position is directly related to the efforts of our Quartermaster and Canteen Manager, who work together to control operational expenses and search for ways to grow our club business. So far, summer canteen participation rates have been good, compared to the dips that we saw in the same period in 2016 and 2017. We know this information by reviewing our canteen Point of Sales (POS) system tracking data, which provides us with daily and monthly reports that tracks customer food and drink orders. As the Post Commander, I closely monitor this information and other financial reports every month. The Post trustees review and verify the Post Quartermaster's financial books during every monthly meeting. Every officer of this Post understands it is their duty to maintain a close over watch of Post funds and assets. However, each new month and season produces different challenges and opportunities. The officers of the board for VFW Post 7201 take their responsibilities as the governing body for this Post very seriously. The VFW mission to support the Veterans of our community, maintain and improve our Post facilities, and respond to our members needs is always our primary goal. We will continue striving to improve and endeavor to do our best in the future.

This summer it has been great to see members meeting friends at the canteen and enjoying a meal. Post membership growth and increased use of our canteen's services is important to our future. Thank you all for your support.
