MEETING REPORTS: The Wisconsin Towns Association Meeting was held at the Newton Town Hall on September 20, 2018. The WTA Manitowoc County Unit would like to pass some bylaws just for the Manitowoc Unit that will be brought up at the WTA Convention. A guest speaker talked about herself being the mediator for Governor Walker. Chairman Christel attended a ATV meeting and found out that road signs could be placed at the boarder roads if we were to let ATV's use the Town of Eaton's roads. There would be 14 signs that would have to be put up in the Town. Chairman Christel and Supervisor Lax attended the Valders Ambulance meeting that was held in Valders
