

# The 2019 *B.A.S.S. Nation*Wisconsin High School and Junior Team Championship

Please see enclosed the Wisconsin State B.A.S.S. High School/Junior Team Championship registration information.

Here is a summary of the information for the event:

- 1) This is a Team Tournament, you and your partner fish together for this event. You are required to find your own boat captain and partner.
- 2) The team limit is five fish, any combination of Largemouth or Smallmouth Bass, which can be caught by any member of the team. 14 inch Bass are LEGAL TO BE CAUGHT AND WEIGHED AT THE TOURNAMENT.
- 3) You only need two high school members to form a Team. <u>High School aged anglers must fish on a High School team.</u>
- 4) The High School members need to be from the same school district. Junior anglers do not need to be from the same junior club for the junior team championship.
- 5) You need to be a B.A.S.S. Nation High School member (\$20.00) Paid to B.A.S.S.
- 6) You need to be a WI B.A.S.S. Youth member (\$30.00) Paid to WBN Youth
- 7) The entry for the event is \$60.00 and registration is due by May 24th.
- 8) The event is on June 8th<sup>th</sup>-9th on the Madison Chain of Lakes. This is a 2 day tournament with the cumulative weight of both days determining the standings.

The official rules meeting is on Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. Registration starts at 4:30p..m

### WEIGH-IN:

All participants will arrive at the docks at the take off-site at the designated time, it is your responsibility to make sure the boat check representative is notified of your return time to the dock. Each Team is responsible for bagging and transporting their fish to the weigh in stage. Both High School Team members are required to go to the weigh in stage for your weight to count. The coach/adult boater can remain in the boat.

All National qualifiers will require a parents and participant signature on the Agreement and a copy of their most recent grades with a current up to date GPA from their school prior to final approval.
