

YRHA GREEN RULES

YRHA GREEN HORSE

- **NO Membership Restriction!!!!!!**
- **NO AGE RESTRICTION!!!!!!**
- **Horse must have less than \$1000 NRHA earnings.**

***NEW* YRHA GREEN Reining 101**

- **MUST BE A YRHA MEMBER.**
- **No NRHA memberships / licenses required.**
- **Must be in the first 3 years of NRHA competition.**
- **Cannot have more than \$200 LTE or have 50 or more youth & 100 or more green points.**
- **Riders will follow NRHA Green Hand Rules.**
- **May use the horn without penalty.**
- **Patterns will be MODIFIED with NO lead change. Horses will come to a stop.**
- **Once you have won the 101 year end award twice, surpassed the earnings or competitively shown in another reining class you must move on from 101.**

NRHA GREEN 1

- **Open to any rider holding a valid NRHA Associate or Non Pro Card**
- **Has less than \$200 in NRHA lifetime earnings**
- **Has less than seventy (75) NRHA Youth Points**
- **Has less than two-hundred (200) Green Reiner points**

NRHA GREEN 2

- **Open to any rider holding a valid NRHA Associate or Non Pro Card**
- **Has less than \$350 in NRHA lifetime earnings**
- **Has less than one-hundred seventy-five (175) NRHA Youth Points**
- **Has less than three-hundred fifty (350) Green Reiner points**

SIMPLE LEAD CHANGE PENALTIES PER THE NRHA HANDBOOK

Section 1. In classes which allow simple lead changes, the ideal change is to jog for one stride to change leads. Any deviation from the ideal change that takes place in the lead change area as described by the Handbook would not incur a penalty but deserves less credit. In order of decreasing difficulty would be jogging more than one stride, walking rather than jogging, stopping during the change and finally more than one attempt to execute the change. Penalties would apply if the lead change was early or late just as they would for a flying lead change.
