Clive Michael Law 14 May 1954 – 10 June 2017

Clive M. Law was a member of the Canadian Association of Veterans in United Nations Peacekeeping, and president of the Col. John Gardam Chapter, Ottawa, Ontario. He was also a driving force in the creation of a fourth figure on the National Peacekeeping Monument, to honour service by peace officers on UN missions. A former officer of the Governor General's Foot Guards, he served as a civilian member of the RCMP with the United Nation Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH) from January to October 2009. Clive was also well known as an author who wrote 12 books and published over 100 titles through his publishing house, Service Publications. His interests also included the collection and restoration of militaria in his personal museum, especially his fleet of street-legal military vehicles. Clive's passion for transportation transferred well to his day job, as well, where he was a Director General with Transport Canada.
