

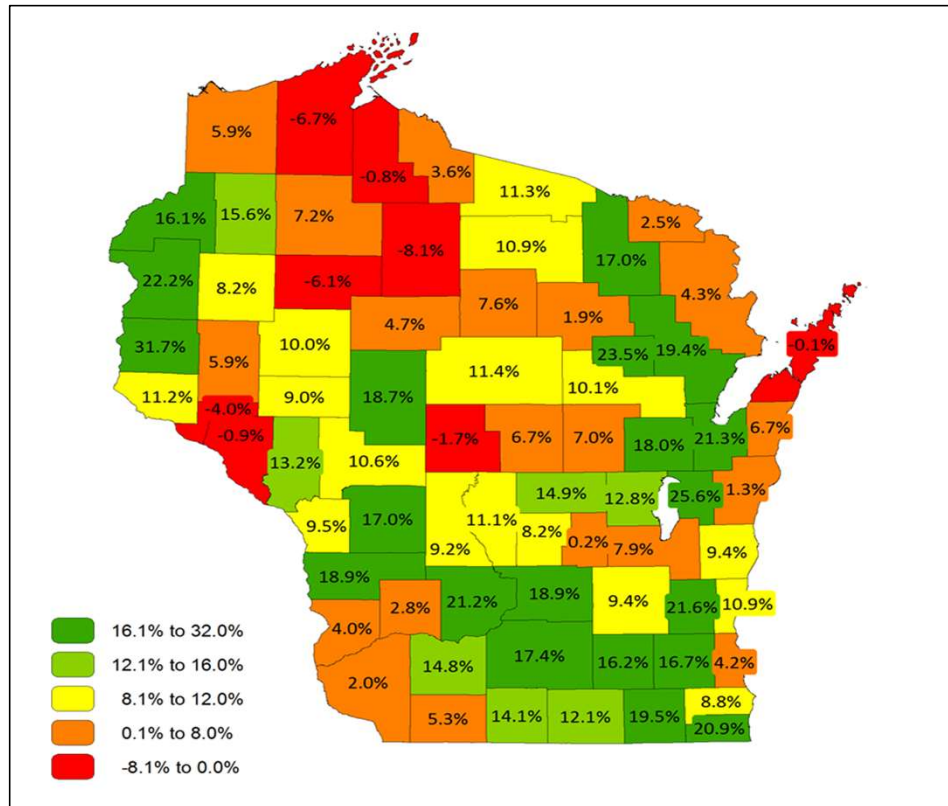

# Projected Population Change 2015-2035



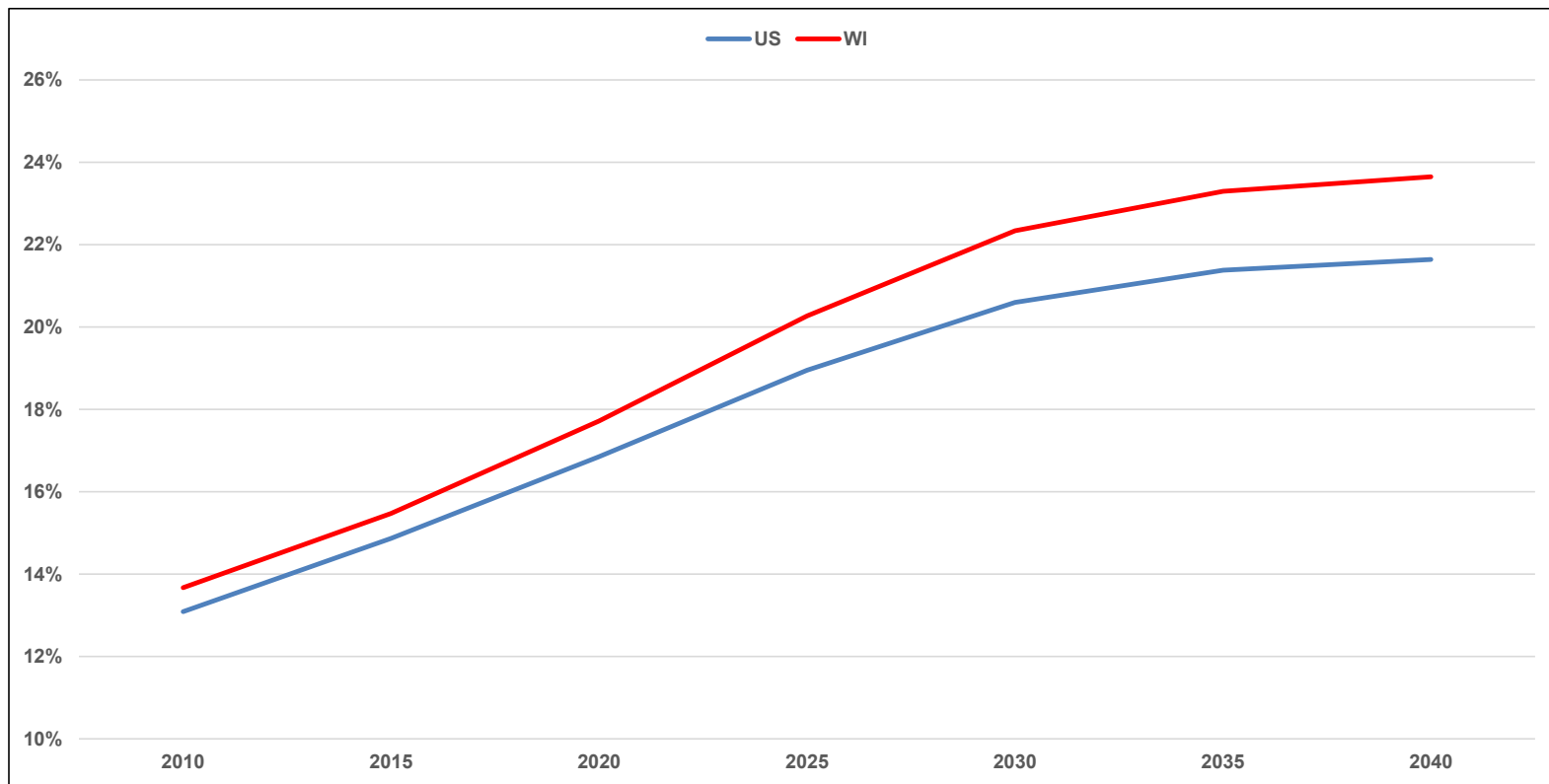
WI = 12.0%

# Percent of Population Aged 65 & Over

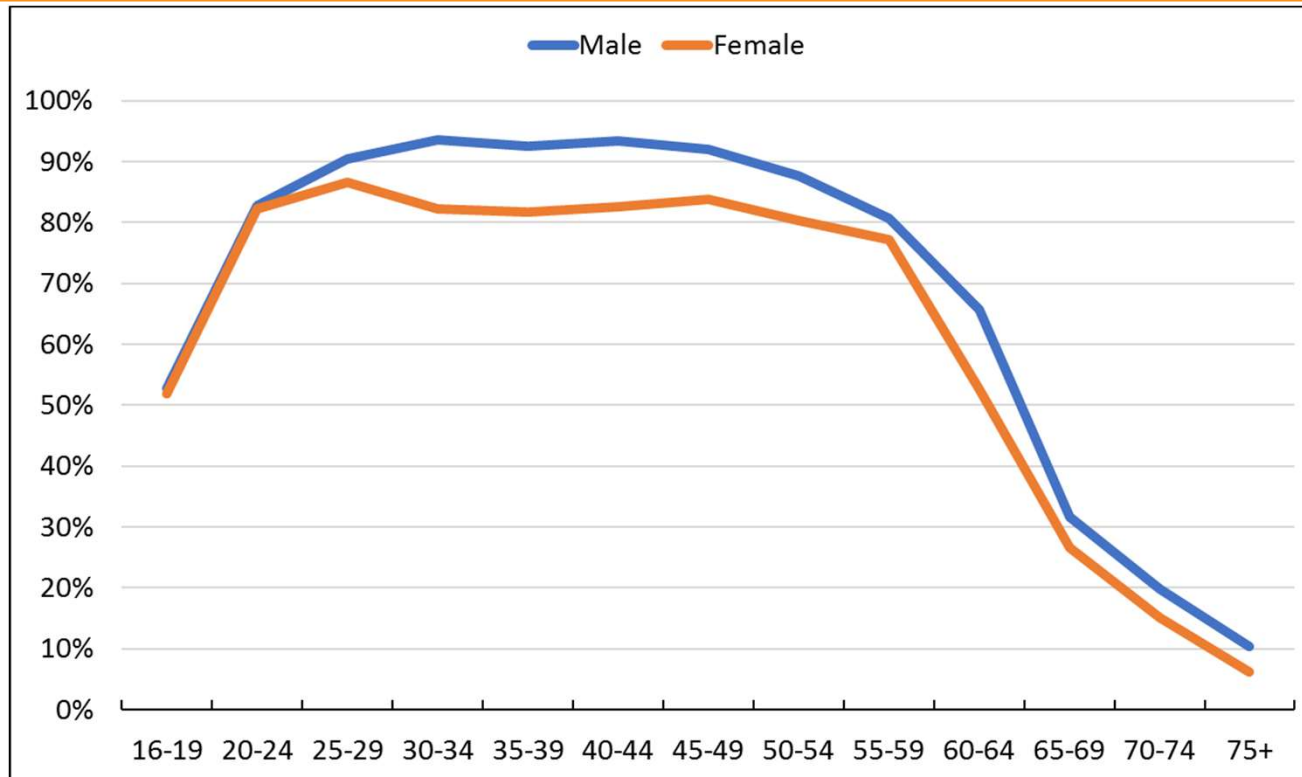

# Labor Force Participation Rate by Age

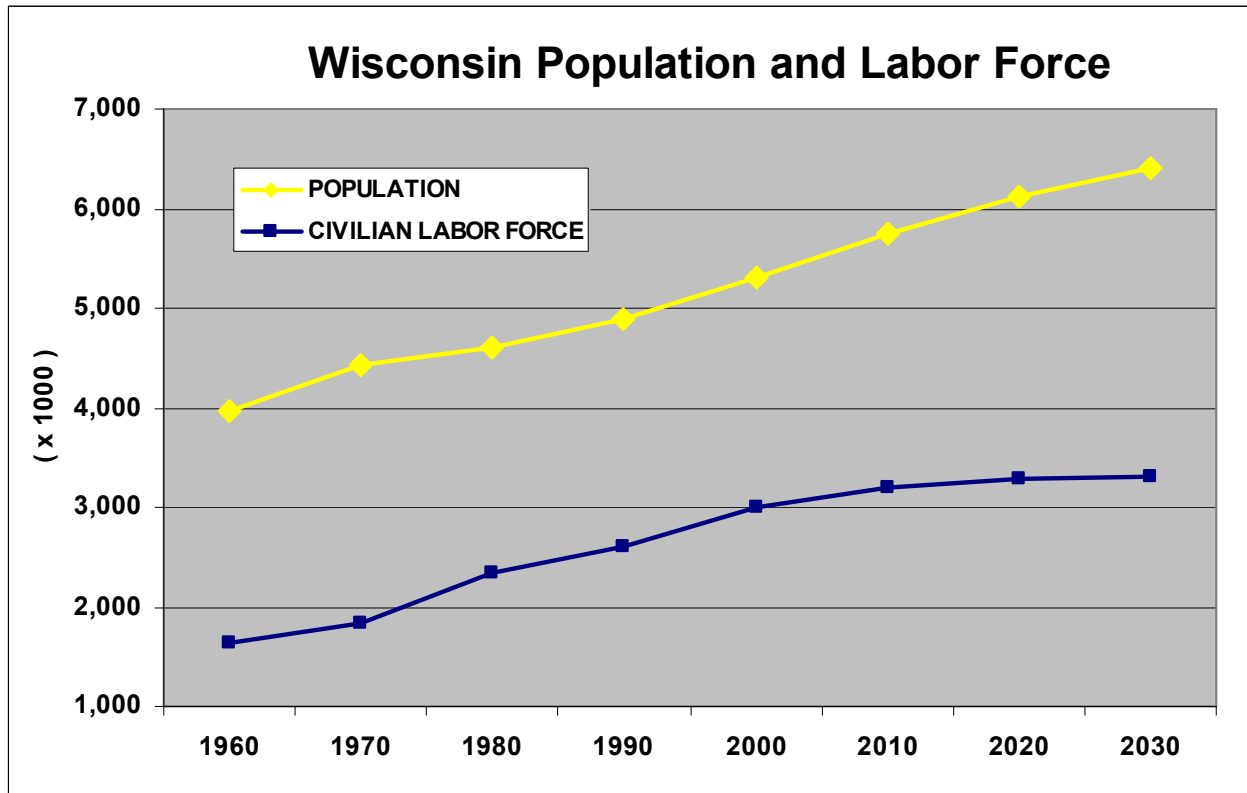

# Wisconsin's Workforce Growth

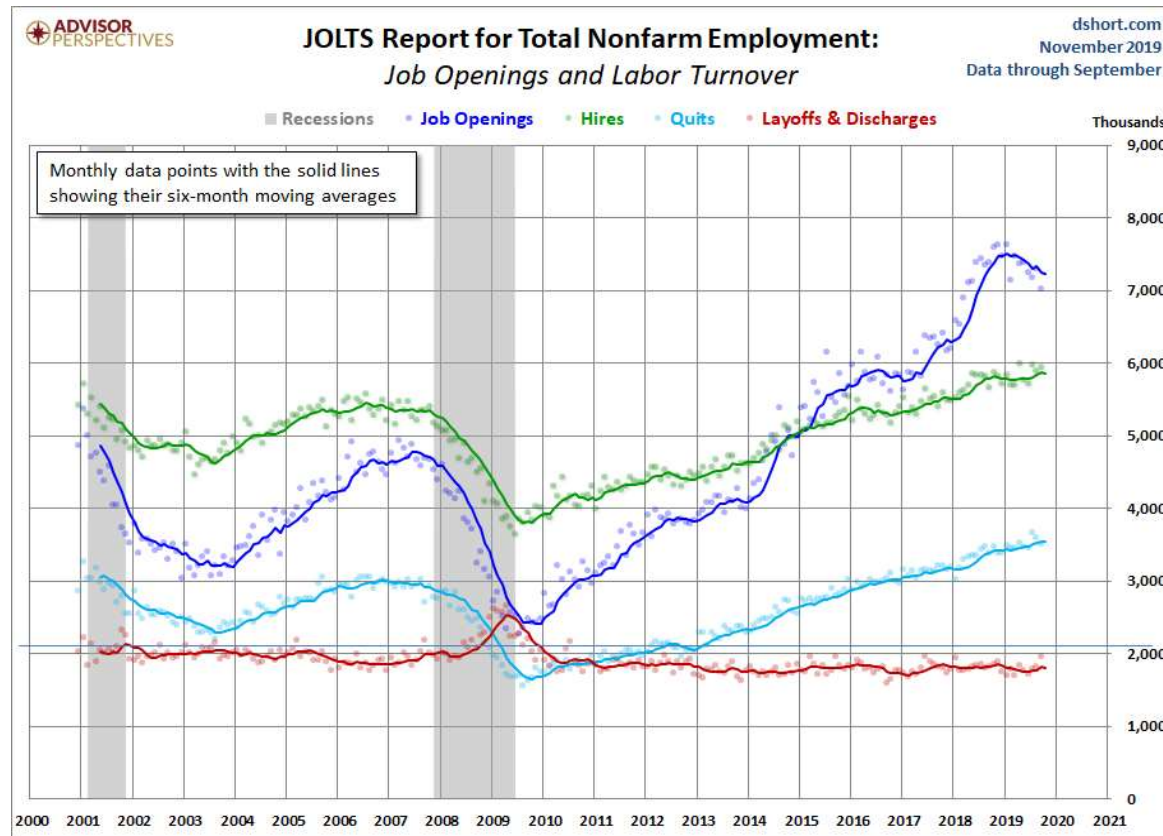

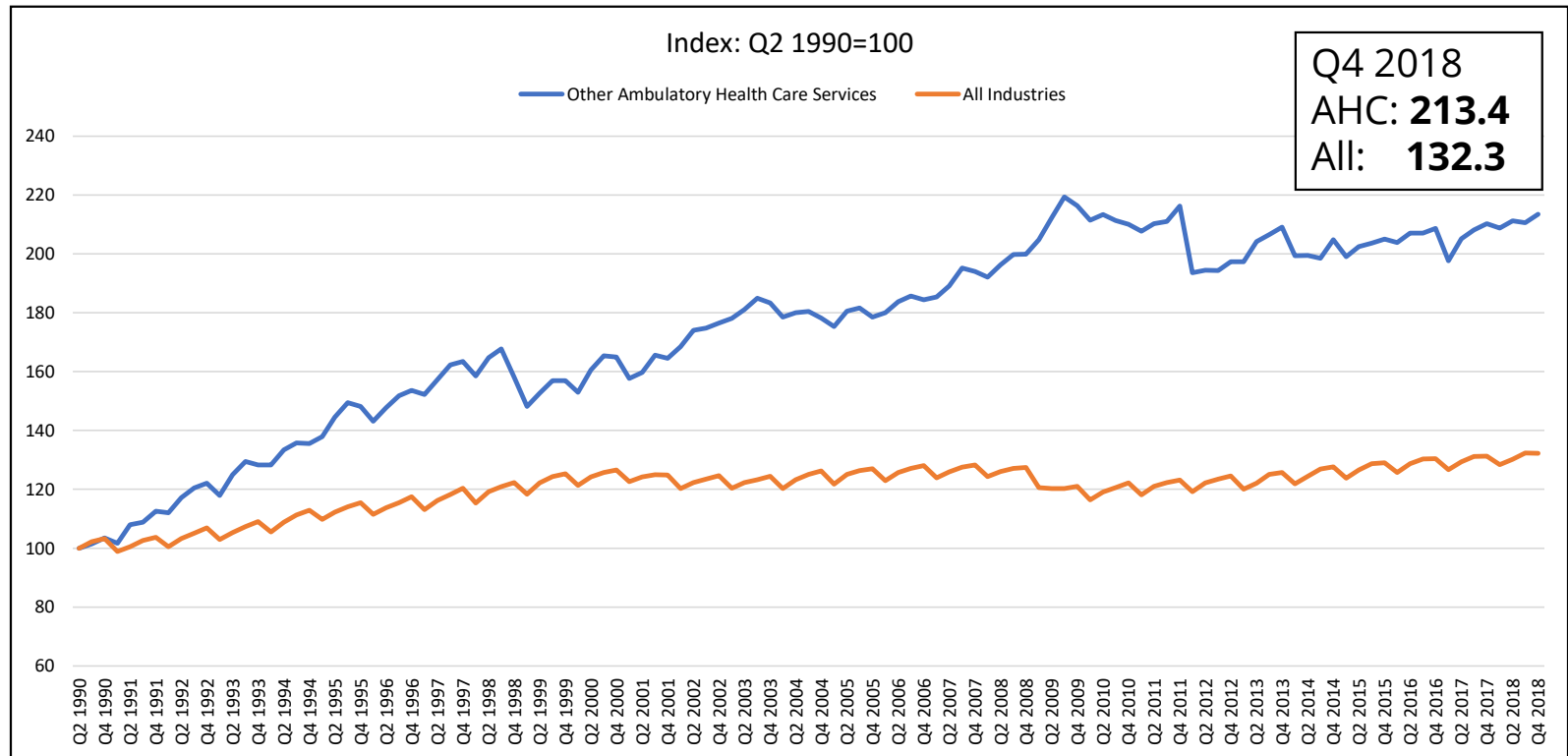

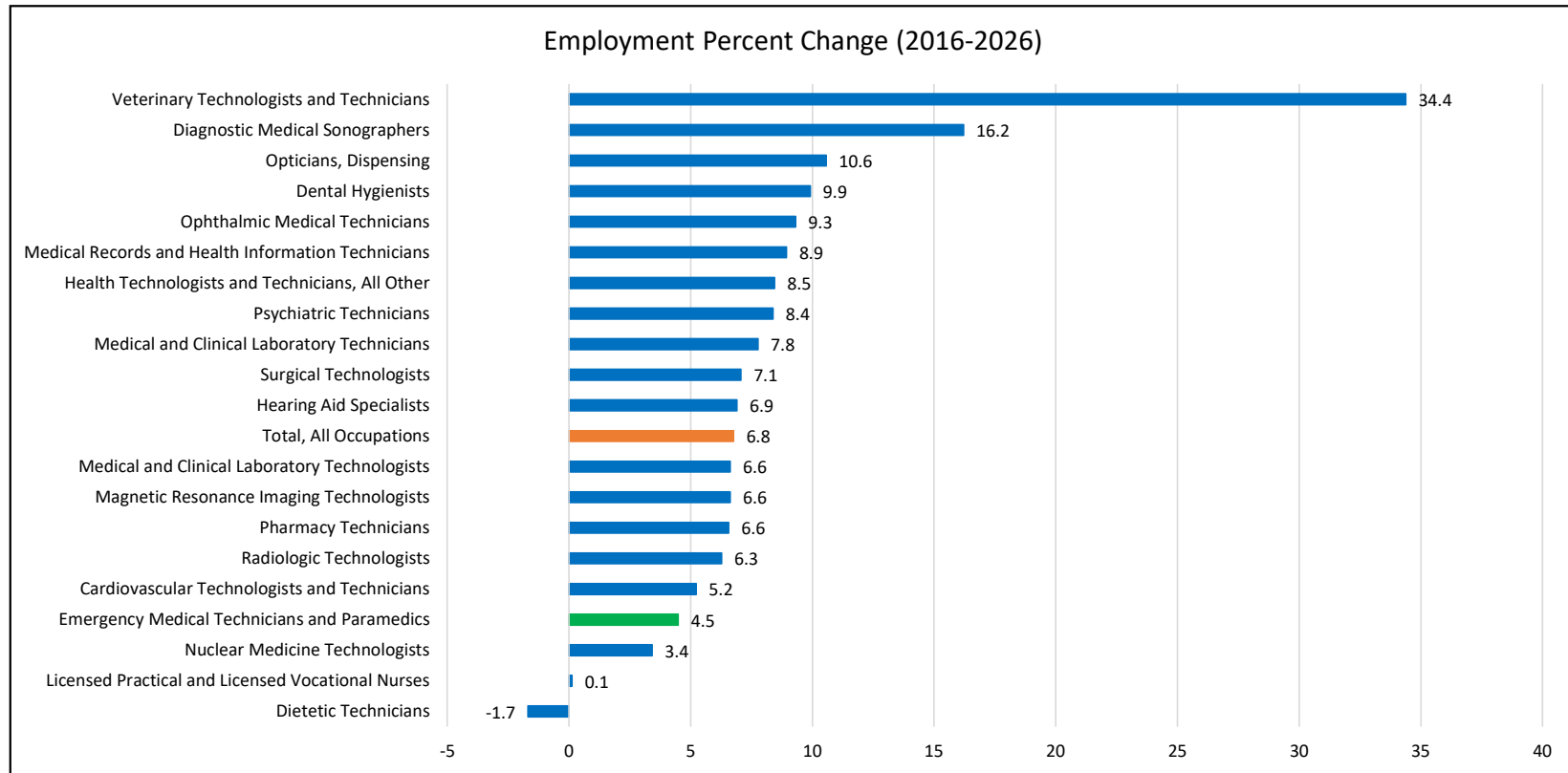

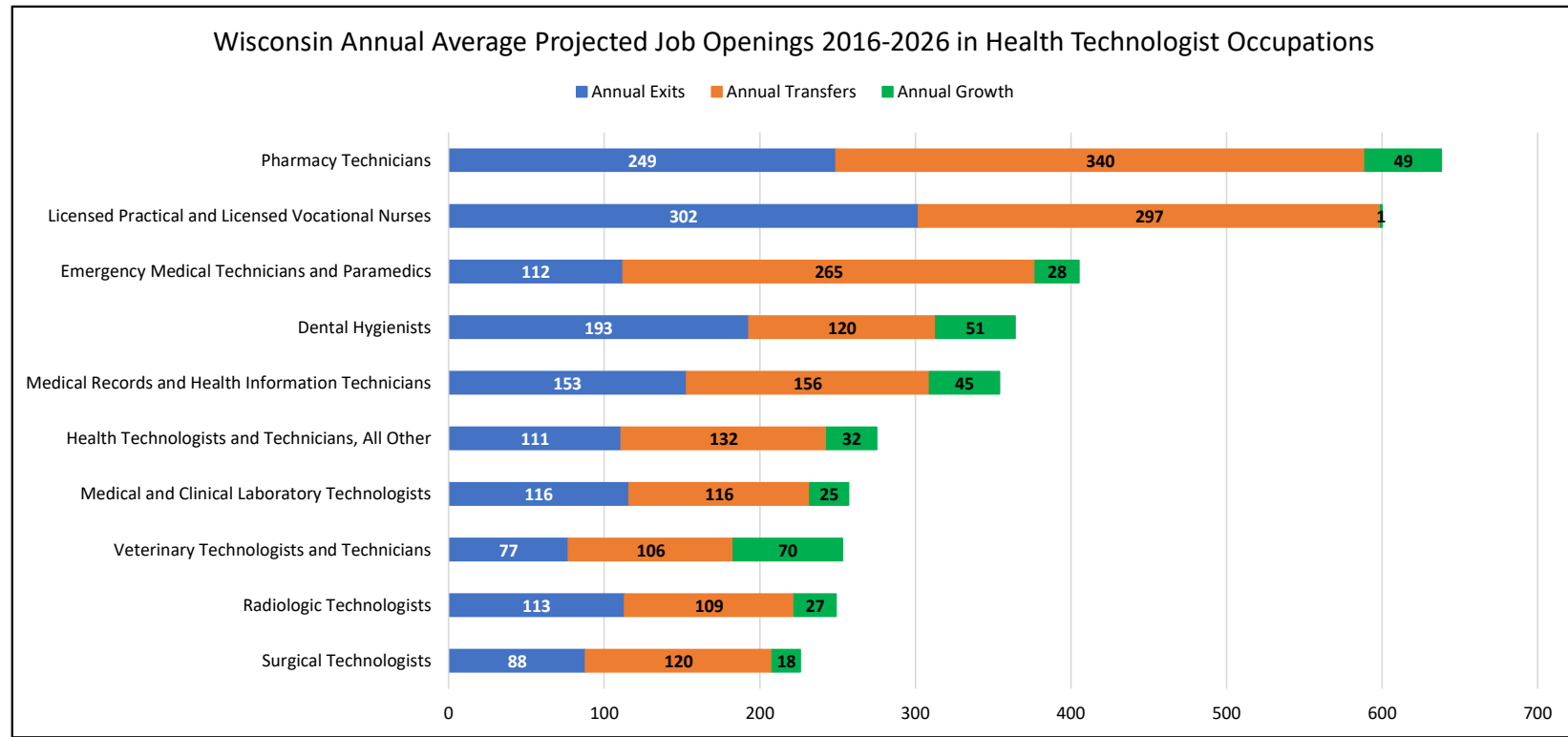

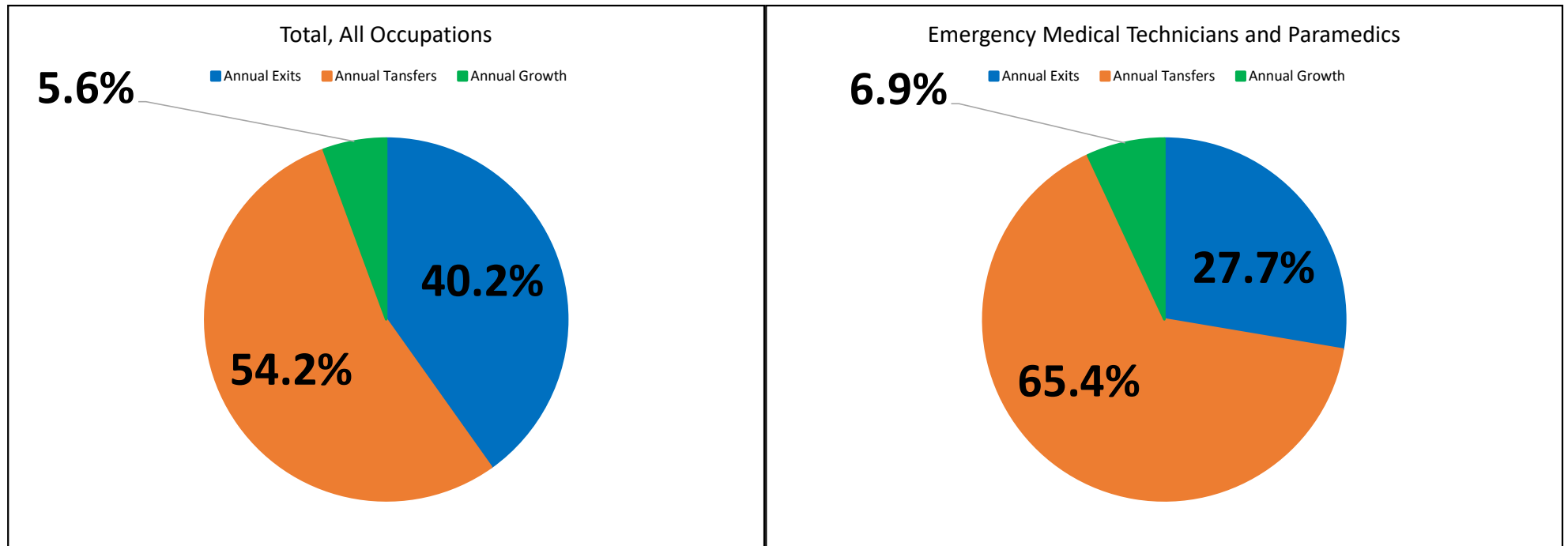
# Sources of Job Openings

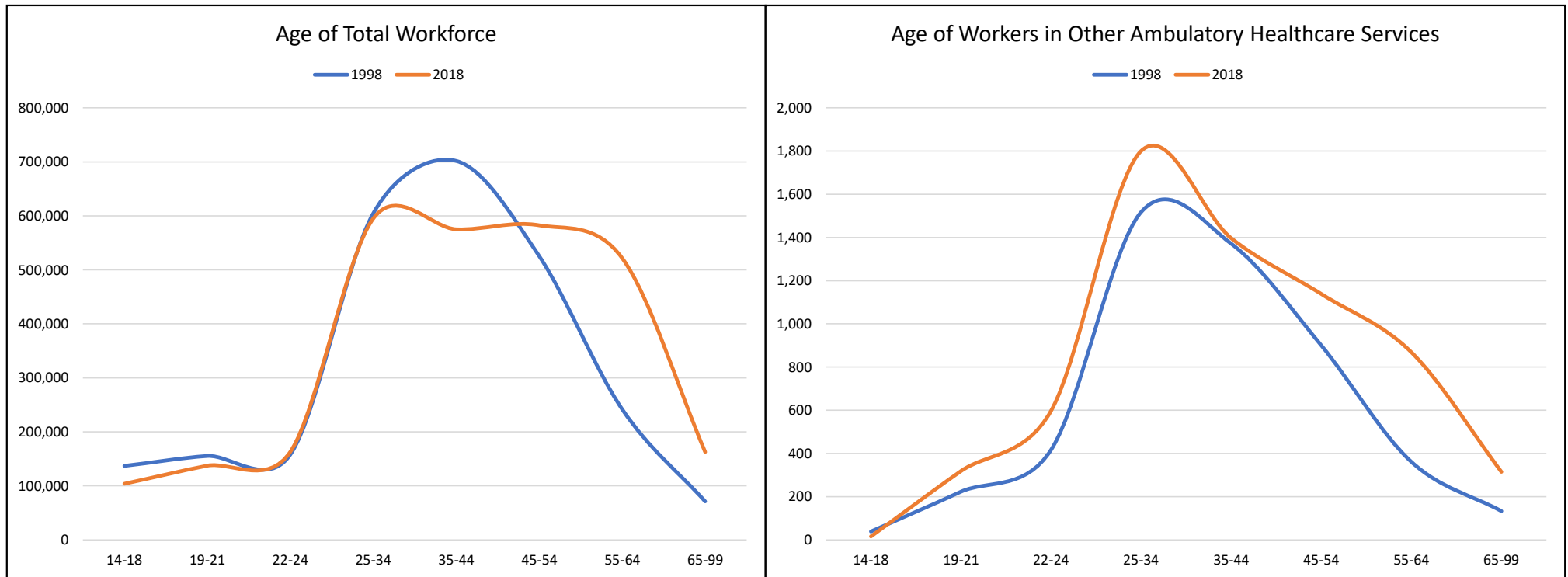

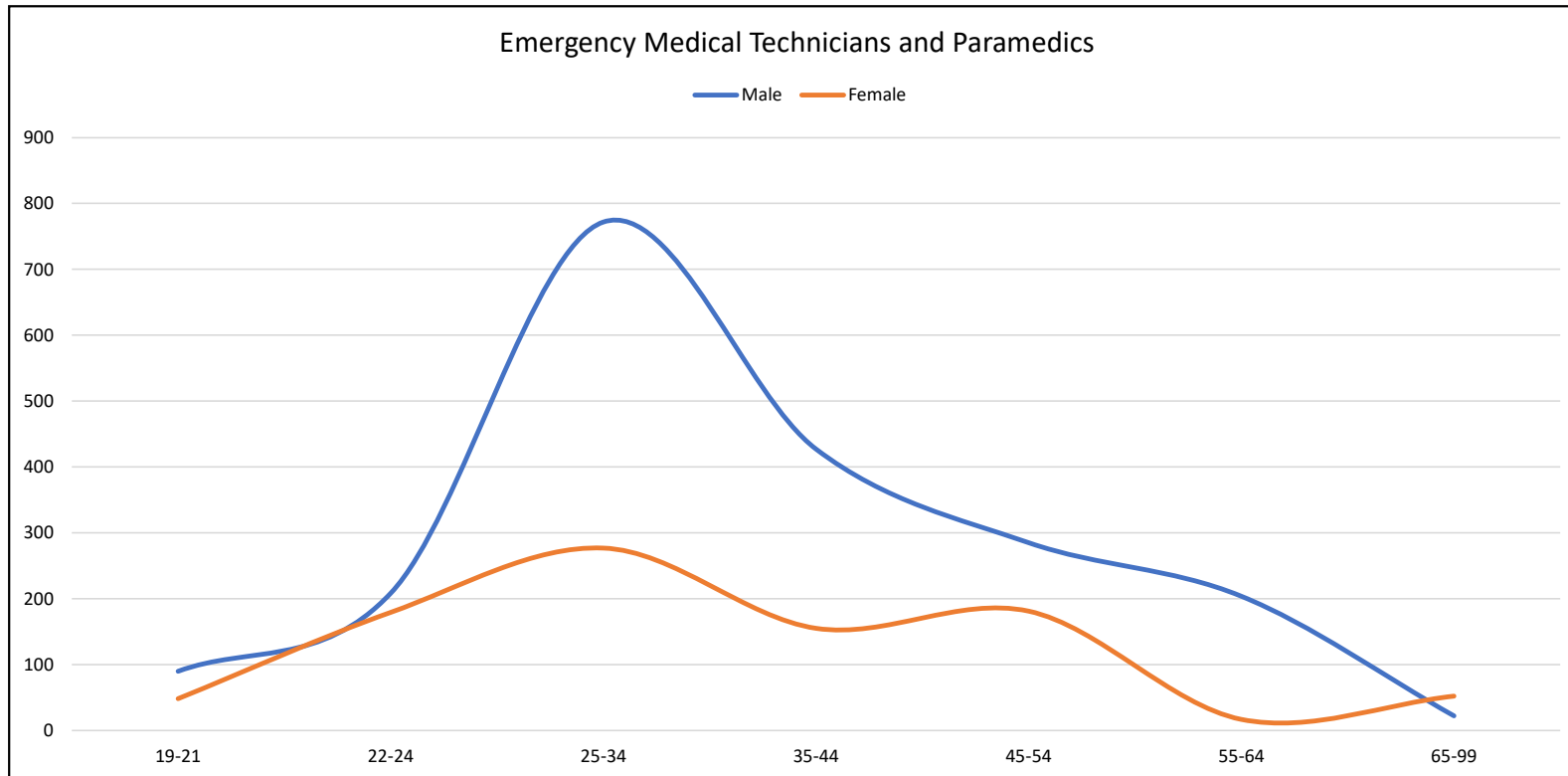
# Age Distribution
