## Job Description Bullgang

The Bullgang position is a general maintenance position and does not have an assigned "ride" or area. Work schedule for Bullgang is generally Monday through Friday and available for after-hours emergencies during evenings and weekends during the irrigation season. This position reports to the Foreman and Superintendent, and is a non-exempt employee.

A Bullgang employee will need to have the following skills:

- Good communication skills
- Have good organizational skills
- Solid decision-making skills and be a motivated self-starter
- Possess solid math skills
- Ability to operate heavy equipment (dozers, excavators, loader, tenwheeled trucks)

## This position must also:

- Have a clean driving record.
- Be able to obtain and hold a Class A CDL driver's license with Hazmat endorsement (Pioneer will pay the testing fees involved and allow practice time on District equipment) – you will be required to obtain a Class A CDL license within the first year of employment. Permit must be obtained within 90 days of employment.
- Be able to obtain and hold a Chemical Applicator's License and applicable endorsements (Pioneer will pay for study materials and testing) – The timeline to obtain a license will be subject to terms when hired
- Must meet all requirements to wear a full-face respirator
- Must wear appropriate provided safety clothing and equipment
- Be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Be willing to be on-call throughout the water season
- Experienced in concrete construction
- Operate ATV
- Adhere to Pioneer's Drug Free Idaho Program

## Day to Day Functions Will Include (but not be limited to):

- 1. Assist with maintenance of ditches/canals/delivery headgates, pipelines, etc. as assigned.
- 2. Assist with other off-season maintenance such as burning, mowing, gopher hole repair, etc. as assigned
- 3. Perform aquatic control chemical treatments
- 4. Perform terrestrial weed spraying and treatment
- 5. Assist with District vehicle maintenance and other shop duties as assigned.

- 6. Time off during the irrigation season (that typically runs April 15 October 15 each year) is restricted, and employee must have management approval prior to scheduling time off.
- 7. All Bullgang employees understand that they will accrue comp/overtime for extended work days or after hours on-call periods. Comp time will be issued as time off during the winter months during a time when maintenance is restricted due to weather conditions, or otherwise permitted by the Superintendent.
- 8. All Bullgang employees understand that the work involved is typically outside, all year long. While Pioneer strives to make adjustments to schedules/work in order to avoid the most extreme weather conditions, this is basically an outside position.

Daily tasks includes (but not limited to):

- a. Spraying weeds (vehicle and backpack)
- b. Mowing weeds
- c. Trimming and cutting down trees
- d. Ditchbank repairs (with and without equipment)
- e. Application of in-water pesticides
- f. Manual weed removal (in-water and out)
- g. Construction of Roads
- h. Pipe repairs
- i. Hand digging
- j. Installation of pipelines
- k. Building structures (concrete and wood)
- I. Painting
- m. Welding
- n. Electrical troubleshooting and minor repairs
- o. Use of high pressure equipment (sandblasting, concrete sealers, etc)
- p. Equipment service and repair
- g. Operate various heavy equipment
- r. Operate various hand tools
