## Summer 2020 May Start with a Warm, Wet June

Away from CBS 3 TV, I teach meteorology courses for Northland College in Ashland and Lake Superior College in Duluth. The pandemic put the kibosh on class in early March and I had to do the rest of the semester online with video lectures on youtube and tests done by email. Lots of parents had to do similar things with their kids to keep them going with distance learning.

Even though summer is here now, some parents may want to keep their kids learning as we regroup towards fall and hopefully a fresh start. NOAA hopes those folks will turn to them for lessons. For example, NOAA offers several climate primers at their website [climate.gov](http://climate.gov). I will probably look at those, too. My meteorology degree from back in the stone age included only two climate courses and things have probably changed some in the last 30 years, to put it lightly.

Now, let's talk about this year's temperature trends: 2020 this far along has ranged from a low of 2.4 degrees below mean for April to a high of plus 5.9 degrees in January. May was 0.2 degree warmer than normal according to the stats compiled by National Weather Service Duluth. Rain for May was 2.3 inches below normal. That's good news for the high lake levels that plague some folks, but not such a good deal for the wildland fire danger that keeps bubbling up out there.

This June may have the solution to the fire risk because even though the month may average four degrees warmer than normal, rain may come up two to four inches more than normal.

June 1<sup>st</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup> may be rainy and cool, but a warmer period that could trigger thunderstorms will be with us from the 11<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup>. The month could then finish hot and dry from the 21<sup>st</sup> to the 30<sup>th</sup>.

The Old Farmers' Almanac tells us that much of the summer will be warmer and wetter than normal. That could spill into Autumn as well with a forecast for September and October that calls for above normal temperatures, but below normal rain.
