<u>Presentation</u> – Rich Garrett, KC9TIY discussed Radio in Medicine (Electrosurgery).

RF energy is used as a scalpel/electrocauterizer. "Isolated" or "loop current" devices are the safest to use. Grounding is not good in electrosurgery. Too much tissue damage is caused by wayward RF energy.

Monopolar electrosurgery cuts smoothly by boiling tissue rapidly.

Bipolar electrosurgery has two poles, like a forceps. The current does not spread and seals blood vessels. The energy stays between the two electrodes.

Dentists and veterinarians need to use isolated equipment.

There was a hands-on demonstration of an electrosurgical device cutting a section of meat.
