- 3. Please bring exact change (if possible) if not using a credit card. Many vendors are rounding the purchase to the nearest dollar to limit the handling of cash.*
- 4. Please remember that people may be waiting to get into the market. For this reason, please talk and catch up with your friends outside the market area.*
- 5. Please be patient with us as we are operating under strict restrictions and procedures. We worked very hard to get open, please help us stay open.*
