Banana Cake

From the Kitchen of Pat Paulette

Recipe from the FPC "Chosen to Serve" Cookbook

Ingredients:

1/2 cup shortening
1-1/2 cups sugar
2 eggs, beaten
1/4 cup sour milk
1 cup mashed bananas
2 cups flour
1/2 tsp. baking soda

Frosting:
3 Tbsp. oleo
3 Tbsp. milk
3 Tbsp. brown sugar
Powdered sugar

Directions:

Cream shortening and sugar. Add eggs, then sour milk and bananas. Stir in flour and baking soda. In 9"x13" pan, bake at 350° for 40 minutes or until done. To make nonfat, use applesauce in place of shortening and Egg Beaters for egg.

Frosting: Boil oleo, milk, and brown sugar. Add powdered sugar and beat.

Note: To make 1 cup sour milk for baking, use 1 Tbsp. vinegar or lemon juice and enough milk to equal 1 cup. Stir and let stand for 5 minutes before using.

1 cup cauliflower pieces
1 cup broccoli pieces
1 large bottle button mushrooms
1 can water chestnuts
1 bell pepper, sliced round
15 cherry tomatoes
1 cup celery pieces
1 small bottle spicy Italian dressing

Directions:

Mix all ingredients together. Stir several times before serving. It is better if it marinates for at least 4 hours in refrigerator.

Ingredients:

1 box yellow cake mix
1 cup milk
4 eggs, large
½ cup oil
1 can pecan-coconut icing mix

Directions:

Combine cake mix, milk, eggs, oil and icing together and mix well. Grease and flour a tube pan, and pour mixture into pan. Bake at 350° until toothpick comes out clean.

Mother's Breakfast Strata

Recipe from the FPC "Recipes in Remembrance" Cookbook

Ingredients:

12 slices bread
12 slices cheese
4 – 6 eggs
2-2/3 cups milk
Salt and pepper

Directions:

"Pam" bottom of baking dish. Tear bread and cheese into pieces and layer alternately in 9" x 13" pan. Beat together eggs, milk, salt and pepper, and pour over all. Cover and let stand in refrigerator 3 hours to overnight. Bake at 325° for 45 minutes covered or uncovered. Cheese seems better if it stands a few minutes before serving.

Notes: A meat layer can be added also – ham, green chilies, shrimp, crab, bacon, etc. If there is no meat layer, bacon, ham, sausage, etc. can be served as a side accompaniment.
