Harry S. Kozlowski, 85, lifelong resident of Port Austin, passed away Tuesday, Jan. 13, 2009 at Courtney Manor, Bad Axe.

He was born Jan. 4, 1924 in Huron County to the late John and Mary (Jaworski) Kozlowski.
