

Wild Geranium

This Native perennial is beautiful as well as useful. It is great for the woodland garden and naturalizing. It is known to be deer and rabbit resistant as well as drought tolerant. The seeds attract Mourning Doves and Bobwhite Quail among others. Wild Geranium is a beneficial nectar source for many Native Bees and Bumble Bees. This plant also has important medicinal uses. It can be utilized for aiding in blood coagulation, sore throat, mouth ulcers, toothache, hemorrhoids and painful nerves. .

Geranium maculatum

- Hardiness: Zone 3-8
- Size: 1-2'
- Habit: Mounded. Will self seed in ideal conditions
- Flower: Pale to deep pink/lilac, April to June
- Culture: Full sun to shade. Prefers moist, humusy soils, but tolerates poor soils
- Use: Shade garden, woodland garden, butterflies, birds, tolerates drought, deer and rabbits, medicinal
