

EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Leadline - Two age groups: 4 & Under, 5-7 Year Olds. Judged on equitation. Diagonals not to count. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes at this show. Ties for Champion or Reserve will go to the rider with the most points in the walk-trot class.

Walk-Trot - Open to junior or adult amateur riders who have not shown at a canter at any horse show, may cross enter into any other WT classes as eligible.

Shortest Stirrup - Ages 8 and under. Fences to be crossrails.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Ages 10 and under. Fences to be crossrails.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to junior or adult amateur riders in their first or second year of showing. Fence height 18".

Junior Equitation - Open to junior riders on horses and ponies. Fence height 2'6" for horses, 2' for ponies.

Low Adult Equitation - Open to all adult riders on horses and ponies. Fences 2'.

Adult Equitation - Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Fences 2'6".

HUNTER DIVISIONS & PLEASURE DIVISIONS

Short Stirrup Hunter - Open to Riders 10 yrs and under. Fences to be crossrails.

Modified Hunter - Open to horses or ponies, junior or adult amateur riders. Fences 2', no oxers.

Low Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior riders on ponies. All ponies jump 2'. May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter.

Children's Pony Hunter - Open to Junior Riders on ponies. Small/Medium ponies to jump 2', Large ponies to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Low Children's Pony Hunter.

Low Children's Hunter Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Children's Hunter.

Children's Horse - Open to Junior riders on horses. Fences 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low Children's Hunter.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Fences 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'9"-3'. May not cross enter into Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing, regardless of age. Trotting anywhere on course not to be penalized. To jump crossrails.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to all riders on horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences. Section A: 2', Section B: 2'6". Simple changes of lead will not be penalized.

Green Hunter - Open to horses of any age, in their first or second year of showing, not to have shown over fences exceeding 3'. Fences 2'9".

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to any Thoroughbreds, all riders. To jump 2'3".

Low Hunter - Open to horses or ponies, all riders. Fences 2'6".

Pleasure Pony - Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Judged on manners, reliability and kindness. Crossrails.

Pleasure Horse - Open to all horses ridden by juniors or adults. Judged on manners, reliability and kindness. Fences 2'6".

Local Pleasure - Open to all riders on horses or ponies stabled within 75 miles of the Devon showgrounds. Judged on mount, jumps 2'.

Young Hunter U/S - Open to horses (no ponies) five years of age and under, ridden by a junior, amateur or professional.

Young Pony Hunter U/S - Open to ponies five years of age and under, ridden by a junior, amateur or professional.

EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES

Two tests will be built into the first round, no further testing:

100. M&S 2'6" Children's Medal
101. M&S 2'6" Adult Medal
102. M&S Children's Pony Medal - 2' Small/Medium ponies, 2'6" Large ponies
103. M&S Children's Horse Medal - 3'
104. M&S Adult Amateur Medal - 3'

BRASS RING HUNTER CLASSICS

Brass Ring Hunter Classics are open to horses and ponies entered in a full division at the show, and cannot be entered as a single class. The second class over fences in the division will be scored as the first round of the Championship. Open numerical scoring will be used. The top 12 scoring entries will be invited to return for a second round in reverse order. Entries for the Classic must be made before the division begins. Formal attire requested, but not required. Four classics will be offered, each pinning to 12th place:

200. Short Stirrup Hunter Classic
201. Low Children's Pony and Children's Pony Hunter Classic
202. Low Children's Horse and Children's Horse Hunter Classic
203. Low Adult and Adult Amateur Hunter Classic

Phase II: Top twelve riders will be invited back to show over fences.

Shavings: \$12.00 per bag, must be pre-ordered with stabling reservations,
and will be delivered to your stalls.

SCHOOLING SCHEDULE

FRIDAY:

- Horses may start to arrive on the showgrounds at 10:00 am on Friday, July 12th.
- Ticketed schooling over fences in the show rings will begin at Noontime.
- Your back number is your ticket, and must be worn by the rider, no exceptions.
- Schooling will be fully supervised, will start at Noontime and close at 6:30 pm.
- Schooling Day Fee is \$50.00 per horse per session, paid via your entry.
- Schooling Day is open to entered horses only.
- Please plan accordingly, using the posted Schooling Schedule, signups will be taken at the gate:

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Horse Show Committee, Brass Ring Horse Shows, the Horse Show organizers, the Devon Horse Show & County Fair or property owners will not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/2023.
3. ASTM approved helmets and boots with a heel must be worn when mounted. No exceptions.
4. The decision of a judge is final.
5. No martingales to be worn in flat classes.
6. The second round of the division will be scored as the first round of a Hunter Classic. Open numerical scoring will be used.
7. Refer to individual organizations as to the rules, regulations and point standings for each. It is an exhibitor's responsibility to adhere to those rules of those organizations as appropriate.
8. All Championships will be placed using the following points for ribbons: 10-6-4-2-1-.5 All ties will be broken. Ties in Equitation Divisions will be awarded to the rider with the most points over fences.
9. Payments may be cash, checks payable to: Brass Ring LLC, or credit cards (3% service fee).
10. **Management reserves the right to limit entries, and to cancel, combine or relocate classes to expedite the schedule. Please pre-enter to avoid disappointment!**
