I am writing to find out if anyone is in need of transportation fees for their SEPTA Keycard to get to work, school, appointments etc. The SEPTA Keycard is the blue card travelers load funds on using the online website, telephone or at one of the electronic kiosks at subway stations/el train stops etc.

The backstory: I used to have transit funds automatically loaded onto my WageWorks commuter card to pay for my commute back and forth to work.

When I was given access to a City vehicle to use while out in the field, I forgot to cancel the auto withdrawals, which leads to my current dilemma. I now have a significant amount of transit funds available to use.

Because the funds are taken "pre-tax" the IRS prohibits refunds so I can't have the money refunded to me.

If you are in need of transportation funds AND have a SEPTA Keycard please TEXT me at 215-526-1924. I am working remotely, so TEXT is the preferred option.

This is free. There's no catch or expectation of payment or trade.
