

## **Eisengruber, Robert**

Robert John Eisengruber, 79, of Sebewaing died Thursday, March 9, 2000, at Bay Medical Center in Bay City following a two-month illness. He was born Feb. 18, 1921, in Sebewaing, son of the late John and Mary (Ort) Eisengruber. He was united in marriage to Ruth E.B. Kunding on Sept. 17, 1949, in Munger.
